Equipment Standards

Manufacturers must have an active representative in the province and be available for consults with clients as necessary.

Eligibility

Only one walking aid permitted per client (e.g. may not have both a cane and walker). Must include client's weight on the authorization.

Cost

Clients are responsible for any charges above benchmark maximum price. Vendors must offer at least one item in each catalogue number at or below benchmark price.

Equipment Standards

- manufacturers must have an active representative in the province who is available for consults with clients as necessary
- distribution of equipment is through AADL-approved vendors that have a facility maintained in Alberta
- minimum three-year warranty on frame, one-year warranty on brakes and casters
- parts must be available from a Canadian distributor/warehouse
- AADL vendor to carry common maintenance parts (e.g. wheels, brakes, handle grips)
- Four-wheeled walkers must be able to accommodate slow down brakes
