Manner of Death: ("manner of death" means the mode or method of death whether natural, homicidal, suicidal, accidental or undeterminable - The Fatality Inquiries Act, Section 1(h)).

Circumstances under which Death occurred:

Mr. Murray Reilly, was found suspended by his neck with a bed sheet ligature, from a pipe fixture exposed in the ceiling of a prison shower stall, on the afternoon of July 29, 2001. The attempts at resusciation were unsuccessful. He was pronounced dead at 1330 hours on the same day.

There is no evidence adduced at this hearing to support any allegation that other inmates were directly involved in Mr. Reilly's death.



Recommendations for the prevention of similar deaths:

Ensure that all fixtures are encased, that may provide a potential aid to a person intending suicide. The pipe fixture which was exposed in the ceiling of the prison shower stall was encased after the death of this inmate.
