



**Alberta Reproductive Health:  
Pregnancies and Births  
Table Update  
(May 2005)**

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## Introduction

This Table Update follows the 2004 Alberta Reproductive Health: Pregnancies and Births report. This is an update of selected indicators, based on data for the 15-year period from 1989 to 2003, and includes new Alberta data for 2003.

### Methodology Notes

“Residence RHA” refers to the regional health authority in which the mother resided at the time of the relevant event. RHA boundaries changed in April 2003; all analyses reflect these boundaries. Only Alberta residents are included in analyses unless otherwise stated.

Statistical analyses are mainly descriptive, including frequencies, rates, percentages, means, and standard errors. Differences between means and rates should be interpreted in terms of standard errors and confidence intervals.

Caution should always be exercised in interpreting rates based on small numbers. Data are often combined across three-year periods (such as 2001 to 2003) in order to increase reliability of rates.

Populations used for the calculations of rates are derived from the Alberta Health Care Insurance Plan Registration Files. They are estimated at June 30, as viewed at December 31 of each year.

Population figures used in calculations in this report are in Tables 18 and 19.

Beginning with 2002 data, new coding systems for classification of diseases (International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems Tenth Revision, Canada (ICD-10-CA) 2003) and interventions (Canadian Classification of Health Interventions (CCI) 2003) are in use. For data prior to 2002 (and for some 2002 data) the International Classification of Disease – 9th Revision – Clinical Modification (ICD-9-CM)) Codes were used. Because the coding systems are not identical, there may be discrepancies between 2002 data and data for prior years. Comparisons of data coded with ICD-10-CA or CCI and those coded with ICD-9-CM should be undertaken with caution.

Because of differences in definitions and dates of extracting data for analyses, the statistics in this report may not be the same as those previously published by Alberta Health and Wellness.

## Summary

### Pregnancies

#### Induced Abortions

- ✓ The induced abortion rate per 1,000 women aged 15-49 was stable between 1999 and 2003. In 2003, the rate was 12.4.

#### Deliveries

- ✓ Induction of labour occurred in 23.1% of live births in 2003. Two thirds of labour inductions were medical inductions.
- ✓ Cesarean section rate was 24.0% for 2003.

#### Maternal Age

- ✓ The average age at childbirth was 29.0 years in Alberta in 2003, continuing an increasing trend. Average maternal age was highest in RHA 3 in 2003.

### Births

#### Fertility Rates

- ✓ The general fertility rate (number of live births per 1,000 women aged 15-49 in a given year) was 47.4 in 2003. 2003 was the only year between 1989 and 2003 in which the general fertility rate was higher than the previous year.
- ✓ The total fertility rate (number of live births per 1,000 women aged 15-49 over a lifetime) was 1,736. This rate is also higher than the 2002 rate.

#### Live Births

##### *Birth Weight*

- ✓ The small-for-gestational-age rate was 7.6 (per 100 live singleton (single infant) births) in 2003, which is the same as the 2002 rate.

- ✓ The low birth weight rate was 6.3 in 2003, down from 6.5 in 2002.

- ✓ The large-for-gestational-age rate was 11.9 (per 100 live singleton births) in 2003, down from a peak of 12.5 in 2001.

- ✓ In 2003, 12.1 out of every 100 liveborn infants weighed more than 4,000 grams, down from a high of 12.9 in 2000 and 2001.

##### *Preterm Births*

- ✓ The preterm birth rate was the 8.9 (per 100 live births) in 2003, surpassing the 2002 rate of 8.6. This rate continues to increase. Prematurity is associated with many negative birth outcomes, and this rate is of concern.

##### *Multiple Births*

- ✓ The multiple birth rate was 3.2 (per 100 live births) in 2003, which is the same as the 2002 rate.

### Mortality

##### *Perinatal and Neonatal Mortality*

- ✓ The neonatal mortality rate (per 1,000 live births) was 4.9 in 2003.

##### *Post-Neonatal Mortality*

- ✓ The post-neonatal mortality rate for 2003 was 1.8 (per 1,000 live births).

##### *Infant Mortality*

- ✓ Infant mortality (per 1,000 live births) was 6.7 in 2003, down from 7.3 in 2002.
