	parsed from the ARIS number, which created the MRTS	
	field using this information. The section polygons for the entire province were converted to points. An overlay (UNION	
	in ArcGIS) of the LUF regions on the ARIS points was	
	completed. The data was exported to MSExcel and summarized	
	by LUF by creating a pivot table from the data. Any LUF	
	missing were later manually guestimated based on the Forest

	No. of FOM inspections- the number of Forest Operations Monitoring (FOM) inspections conducted by the department. This involves inspections of active timber harvesting and reforestation activities, as part of the Forest Operations Monitoring Program (FOMP).
	No. of SAM inspections-the number of Silviculture-ARIS Monitoring (SAM) inspections conducted by the department. This involves the comparison of samples of the Alberta Regeneration Information System (ARIS) database records with the forest company's approved reforestation plan, the company's records and the department's field observations, as part of the Forest Operations Monitoring Program (FOMP).
	Total number of FOMP inspections- The total number of Forest Operations Monitoring Program inspections calculated by adding the number of FOM inspections and the SAM inspections.
	Total timber volume harvested in Alberta (m <sup>3</sup> )- The volume of timber harvested under the authority of the timber disposition.
	Preliminary (p)-number reported for the first time in the Sustainable Forest Management: Current Facts & Statistics. This usually applies to the most recent reporting year of each statistic.
