Exceptional oxygen funding due to COVID

Exceptional oxygen funding due to COVID-19

Due to COVID-19 outbreaks in congregate living facilities, AADL will implement exceptional oxygen funding, effective immediately.

The following exceptions apply only to congregate living facilities and COVID positive clients treated at home.

New oxygen starts

If an arterial blood gas is unavailable, pulse oximetry completed by a regulated health professional documenting hypoxemia will be accepted. SpO₂ must be less than or equal to 89%.

If in-person registered respiratory therapy assessments cannot be conducted (i.e., due to facility access issues), every effort should be made to conduct a phone assessment. The safe use of oxygen and equipment instruction continue to be necessary steps for new oxygen starts.

The procedure to enter a new start on the Alberta Blue Cross online health portal is as follows:

- Enter the start as RH1 auth. Enter a PaO₂ value of 20.
- If the registered respiratory therapy assessment cannot be completed within 48 hours, enter the date on which the equipment was given to the client as the assessment date.
- Provide additional information in the comments section including details about facility access, the reason for not obtaining an arterial blood gas, etc.

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Existing oxygen clients

- Testing (e.g., arterial blood gas, pulmonary function test) is still expected for consideration of ongoing funding.
- If the facility has restricted client mobility out of the facility, please provide qualifying oximetry (SpO₂ ≤ 89%) from a regulated health professional.
- If a COVID positive oxygen client can't obtain the necessary testing, please submit qualifying oximetry (SpO₂ ≤ 89%).
- Please apply for RE1 funding on the Alberta Blue Cross online health portal.
 - Provide additional information in the comments section including the reasons for requesting exceptional funding.
