Authorizers of Alberta Aids to Daily Living Recycle Benefits

The Alberta Aids to Daily Living (AADL) recycle program is moving to a more efficient recycle model. This will result in process changes for authorizers. Please refer to <u>Bulletin #118</u> for more information.

Beginning October 1, 2021, all recycled equipment will be handled by Eco Edmonton or Eco Calgary. Recycled equipment from Red Deer and locations north will go to Eco Edmonton; recycled equipment from south of Red Deer will go to Eco Calgary.

Recycled equipment includes wheelchairs (power and manual), patient lifters, beds, pediatric walkers and pediatric standing frames.

Please inform clients that equipment to be recycled should be sent to Eco Calgary or Eco Edmonton.

All recycled equipment will now be processed by Eco Medical; the equipment will not be sent to the preferred vendor as was previously done. If nothing is available in the recycle pool, the authorization will then go to the preferred vendor.

What is changing?

AADL will be changing the way recycle benefits are accessed and processed. This change will occur in conjunction with the transition of authorizations and claim processing to Alberta Blue Cross, anticipated for the end of January 2022. (Please watch for upcoming bulletins regarding the transition to Alberta Blue Cross.)

There are three planned sessions on different recycle program topics. Please attend one of each of the upcoming information sessions for an overview of changes to the recycle program. It is essential that all clinicians who assess and authorize recycled equipment attend one of each of these sessions.
