Update on Edmonton Police Service altercation at 106A Avenue and 96 Street

On Thursday, October 24, 2013 at 11:09 p.m., members of the Edmonton Police Service came upon an altercation involving a man and a woman in the area of 106A Avenue and 96 Street in Edmonton. While members of the Edmonton Police Service were attempting to detain the 39 year old man, a Taser was deployed. The man was injured during the altercation and transported to hospital. ASIRT was assigned to investigate.

Tragically, the male died in hospital on Wednesday, October 30, 2013. An autopsy will be conducted.

The ASIRT investigation continues.
