# Introduction

The report "**Alberta Trade in Pork and Live Hogs. A Five-Year Perspective**" presents Alberta international trade in pork and live hogs from 1999 to 2003.

The purpose of this report is to provide a five-year trend analysis of Alberta exports and imports of pork and live hogs. Selected comparative data for Canada and the provinces are also provided. This information is presented in the form of statistical tables, figures and highlights.

**The report is divided into two parts:**

**PART I** - provides detailed information on **exports of pork and live hogs** classified by province, country of destination and type of pork and hogs exported.

**PART II** - provides detailed information on **imports of pork and live hogs** classified by province, country of origin and type of pork and hogs imported.

## NOTE TO USERS:

1. Pork statistics presented in this report refer mainly to fresh, chilled, frozen meat and include edible offal. Information on processed pork is also provided and this category refers to cured, prepared and preserved meat.
2. Live hogs statistics refer to purebred and other hogs classified by weight (Less than 50 kg and 50 kg or more).
3. Import data are reported by Statistics Canada on a province of clearance basis. The province of clearance is often not the province of the final destination of imported goods. For this reason, import statistics at the provincial level may not be accurate and should be used with caution.
4. All trade statistics are reported for the calendar year and are ranked by the 2003 year. Trade statistics for 2003 are subject to revision.
5. The source of data is Statistics Canada, International Trade Division.

# Highlights on Alberta Trade in Pork and Live Hogs

## Exports

Nationally, Alberta is the fourth largest exporter of pork among Canadian provinces and is the third largest exporter of live hogs. Quebec remains the largest supplier of pork, followed by Manitoba and Ontario. Manitoba leads the nation in the export of live hogs. Over the past five years (1999-2003), Alberta accounted for 11.7% of the total value of Canadian pork exports, and 17.5% of Canadian value of live hog exports. In 2003, Alberta's share of exported pork from Canada (13.3%) surpassed the five-year average, while the share of exported live hogs dropped below the average to 9.7%, due to increased hog slaughter in the province.

During the last five years, the province's exports of pork more than doubled from \$106 million in 1999 to \$253 million in 2003, while exports of live hogs reached a peak of \$124 million in 2001, before declining to \$54 million by 2003.

In 2003, Alberta's revenue from exports of live hogs (including purebred) fell 28.3% from \$76 million in 2002 and was 56.1% lower than in 2001. The drop in revenue can be attributed to lower hog prices, increased hog slaughter in the province and reduced shipments to the United States. The number of exported hogs declined 23.8% to 425,303 head from 558,481 head in 2002. The United States remains Alberta's sole importer of non-purebred live hogs. At the Canadian level, exports of live hogs reached a record \$560 million and 7.4 million head, up 14.9% from 2002 in value and 29.7% in quantity. Most of these exports were from Manitoba and Ontario.

The decline in exports of Alberta's live hogs was offset by a substantial gain in exports of pork, which rose 31.9% to \$253 million in 2003 from \$192 million in 2002. Also, the quantity of exported pork grew 39.9% to 91,671 tonnes from 65,536 tonnes a year earlier. Between 1999 and 2003, the majority of exported pork was in the form of fresh, chilled or frozen swine cuts (93% of total value), followed by edible offal (4.0%) and swine carcasses (3.0%). During the same period, exports of processed pork, which include cured, prepared and preserved meat, averaged \$9.8 million and 2,754 tonnes. These exports grew steadily from \$3.1 million in 1999 to \$17.3 million in 2002, and then declined 34.4% to \$11.3 million in 2003.

In 2003, the top five markets for Alberta pork (fresh, chilled and frozen) were Japan (\$172 million), the United States (\$46 million), Mexico (\$10 million), Australia (\$9.5 million) and South Korea (\$3.8 million). Exports of pork to these five countries combined (\$241 million) accounted for over 95% of Alberta's total value of pork exports. Also, the United States, Japan and Mexico are Alberta's major buyers of processed pork.

Traditionally, the largest market for Alberta pork was the United States. However, during the last five years (1999-2003) this market has declined. In 1999, Alberta shipped 71.5% of its total quantity of pork exports to the U.S. By 2003, this share dropped to 20.2%. During the same period, the Japan market share rose from 17.6% to 50.4% in quantity, and from 28.8% to 67.8% in value. Since 2001, Japan has become Alberta's largest market for pork. In 2003, pork exports to Japan rose 38.6% in value and 61.7% in quantity. The sharp increase in pork exports to this market was the result of tight beef supplies. The discovery of bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE) and the imposed ban on beef imports from Canada and the United States created a higher demand for pork in Japan. Increases in exports of pork in 2003 were also recorded for other Asian countries including Taiwan, Philippines and Hong Kong. Overall, Alberta exports of pork to Asia quadrupled, increasing from \$35 million in 1999 to \$182 million in 2003. In terms of value, almost three-quarters of Alberta's total pork exports in 2003 went to Asia.

## Imports

Alberta imports of live hogs rose significantly in 2003 mainly due to increased imports of purebred hogs from Denmark. As well, in 2003, Alberta became the largest importer of purebred hogs in Canada bringing into the province 1,203 head of purebred hogs worth \$1.7 million.

Contrary to the increase in imports of live hogs, Alberta imports of pork (fresh, chilled, frozen) declined in 2003 after four years of steady growth. Imports of pork dropped 56.0% to \$5.8 million, from \$13.3 million in 2002. Also, the quantity was down 54.9% to 1,137 tonnes, from 2,524 tonnes a year earlier. Nationally, Alberta was the fifth largest importer of pork, accounting for 5.1% in value and 2.9% in quantity of Canadian imports (1999-2003). Ontario remains the number one importer of pork in Canada, followed by Quebec.

The United States, as always, was Alberta's largest supplier of imported pork. At the Canadian level, Denmark continued to be the second largest import market.

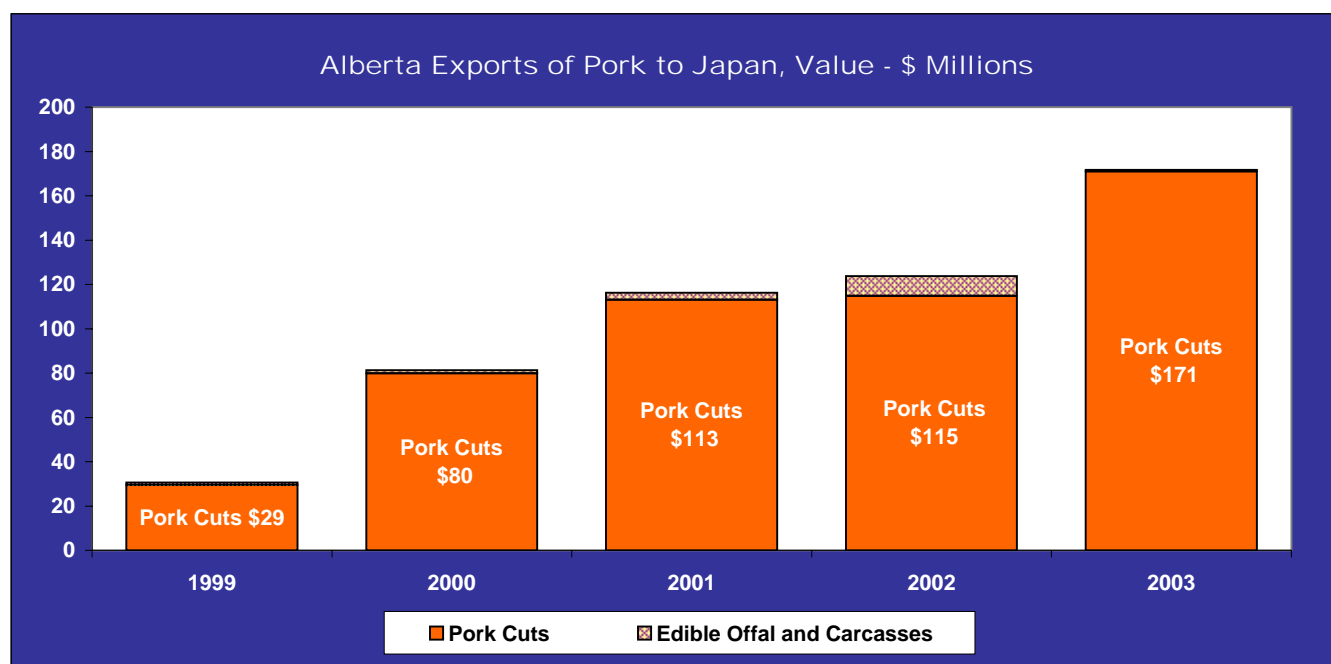

## Alberta Exports of Processed Pork, 1999 to 2003

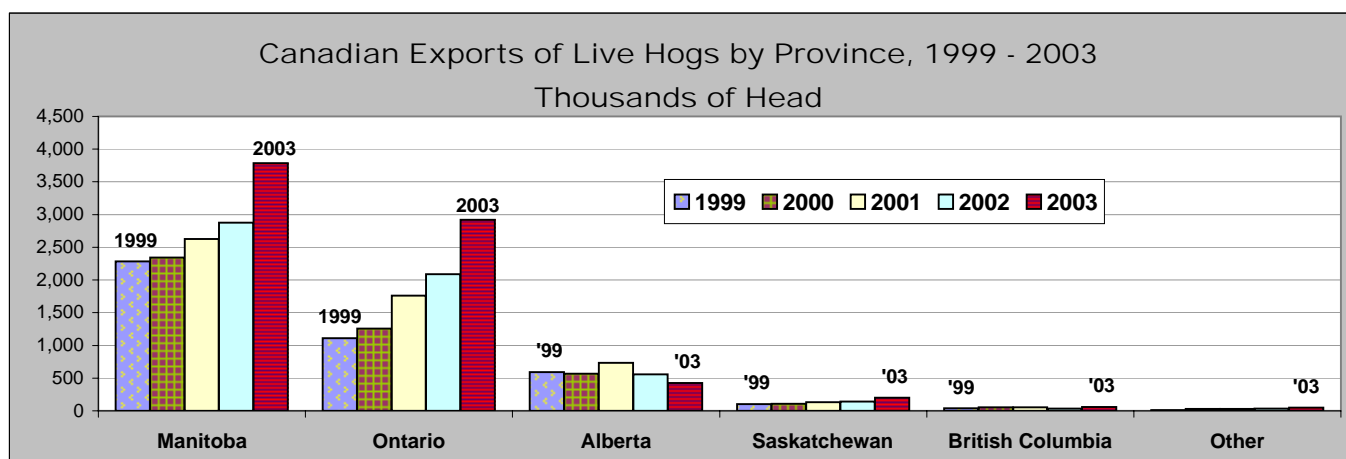

Exports of Live Hogs Weighing 50 kg or More - Alberta as a % of Canada



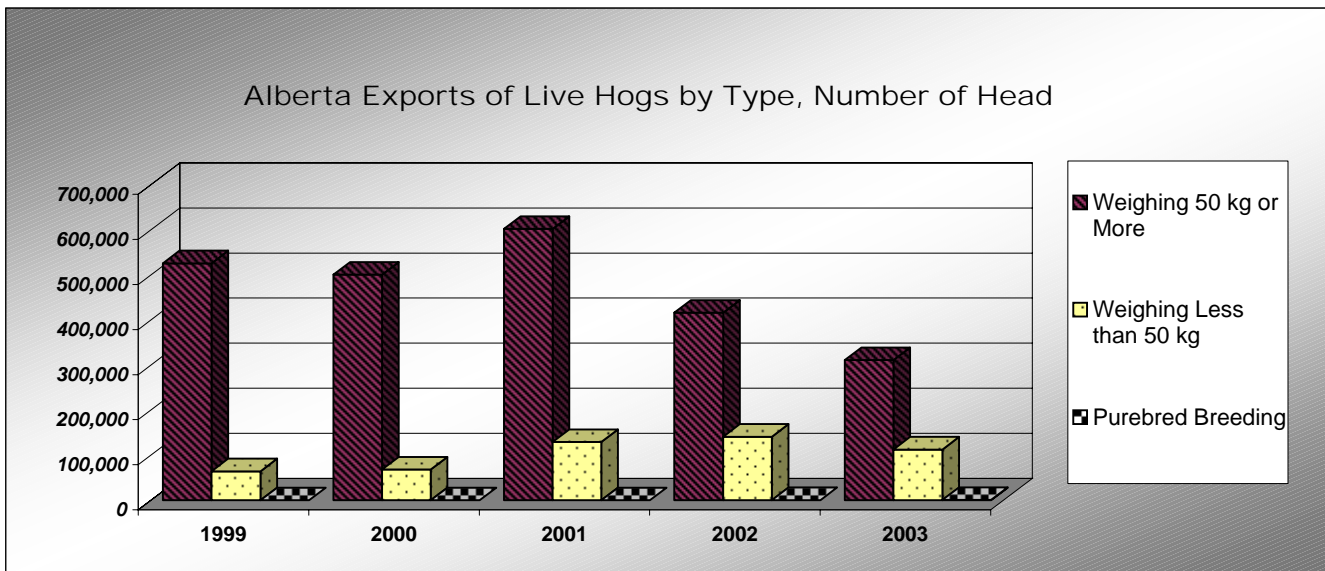
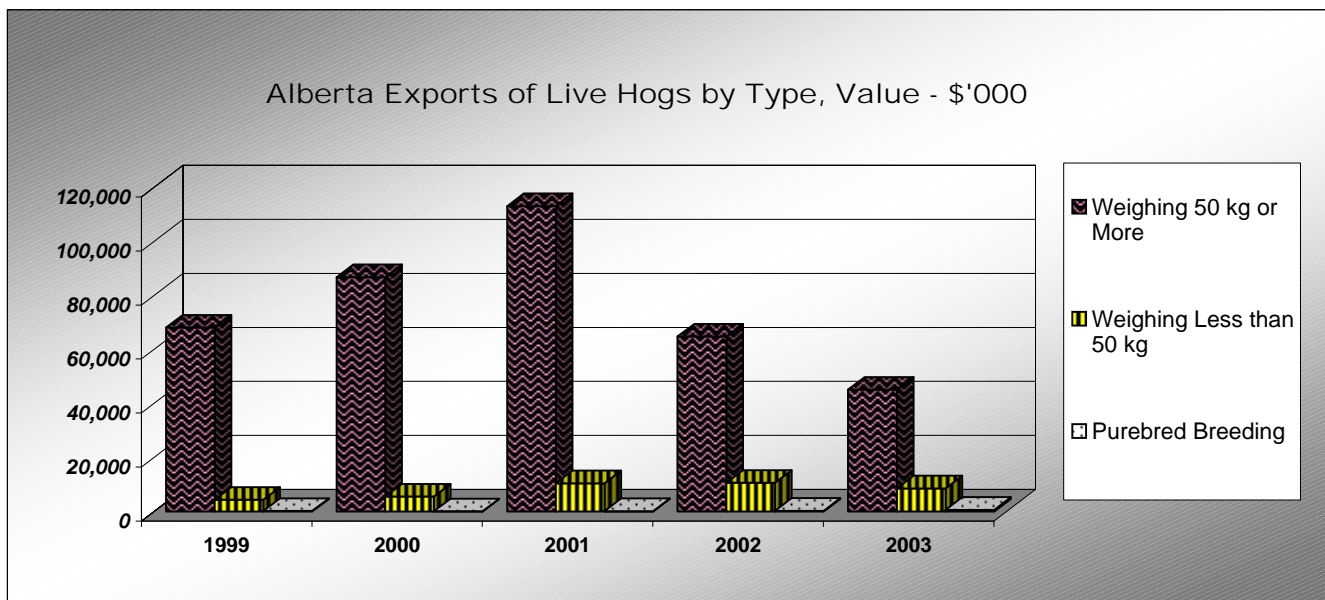
