

## Section 2: Outbreaks


There are four new outbreaks to report this week. Including the outbreaks reported in week 50 there have been 22 influenza outbreaks this season.

#### Section 3: Isolates


In the 2012/13 influenza season, the Provincial Laboratory for Public Health (PLPH) has reported 448 Influenza A cases and 32 Influenza B cases to Alberta Health. In week 50 there were 149 lab confirmed influenza cases.



# Section 4: Hospitalizations

There are 13 new hospitalized cases of influenza reported in week 50. There are 74 hospitalized cases in total for this influenza season.

#### Section 5: Influenza-Like Illness - TARRANT-Week 50

Sentinel physicians report cases of ILI seen in their practices. 15 cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 50.

#### Section 7: Antiviral Resistance

- There have been no influenza isolates identified that are resistant to amantadine, zanamivir or oseltamivir in the 2012/13 influenza season.
- In the 2011/12 season there were 10 isolates that were resistant to amantadine and no isolates were resistant to zanamivir or oseltamivir.
