#### Section 2: Outbreaks


There are no new influenza outbreaks to report this week. There were a total of 2 outbreaks in week 6. There have been 78 influenza outbreaks this season.

# Section 3: Isolates

In the 2012/13 influenza season, the Provincial Laboratory for Public Health (PLPH) has reported 1933 Influenza A cases and 178 Influenza B cases to Alberta Health. There were 79 lab confirmed influenza cases reported to Alberta Health in week 6 and 67\* lab reported in week 7. Note that the number of Influenza B cases has increased from week 6 to week 7.




Laboratory Confirmed Influenza Cases by Strain Type, 2012/13

## Section 4: Hospitalizations

There were 26\* new hospitalized cases of influenza reported in week 7, and 44 confirmed hospitalized cases in week 6. There have been 645 hospitalized cases in total for this influenza season.

### Section 5: Influenza-Like Illness - TARRANT-Week 7

Sentinel physicians report cases of ILI seen in their practices. 38 cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 6 and 16 cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 7.

#### Section 7: Antiviral Resistance

- There have been no influenza isolates identified that are resistant to amantadine, zanamivir or oseltamivir in the 2012/13 influenza season.
- In the 2011/12 season there were 10 isolates that were resistant to amantadine and no isolates were resistant to zanamivir or oseltamivir.
