Section 2: Outbreaks


There were no new influenza outbreaks to report in week 21. There was one influenza outbreak in week 20. There have been 95 influenza outbreaks this season.

Section 3: Isolates

In the 2012/13 influenza season, the Provincial Laboratory for Public Health (PLPH) reported 2,089 Influenza A cases and 758 Influenza B cases to Alberta Health. There were 12* lab confirmed influenza cases reported to Alberta Health in week 21 and 19 reported in week 20. While influenza A has been the dominant strain for the bulk of the season, the majority of influenza cases in recent weeks have been due to influenza B.




Laboratory Confirmed Influenza Cases by Strain Type, 2012/13

Section 4: Hospitalizations

There were 5* new hospitalized cases of influenza reported in week 21, and 14 confirmed hospitalized cases in week 20. There have been 931 hospitalized cases in total for this influenza season. While the majority of hospitalized cases have been due to influenza A, the majority of hospitalized cases in recent weeks have been due to influenza B.

Section 5: Influenza-Like Illness - TARRANT Week 21

Sentinel physicians report cases of ILI seen in their practices. 3* cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 21 and 6 cases were seen in week 20.

Section 7: Antiviral Resistance

- A probable case of oseltamivir-resistant influenza was reported to Alberta Health in week 9. The sample, isolated in Calgary, has been sent to the National Microbiology Laboratory for confirmatory testing. This is the first resistant isolate found in the 2012/13 influenza season.
- In the 2011/12 season there were 10 isolates found to be resistant to amantadine. No isolates were resistant to zanamivir or oseltamivir.
