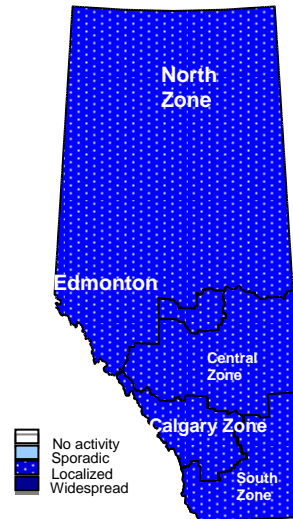


Section 1: Summary

Section 2: Outbreaks

There are 2 new influenza outbreaks to report this week. There were a total of 3 outbreaks in week 4. Including the outbreaks reported this week there have been 76 influenza outbreaks this season.

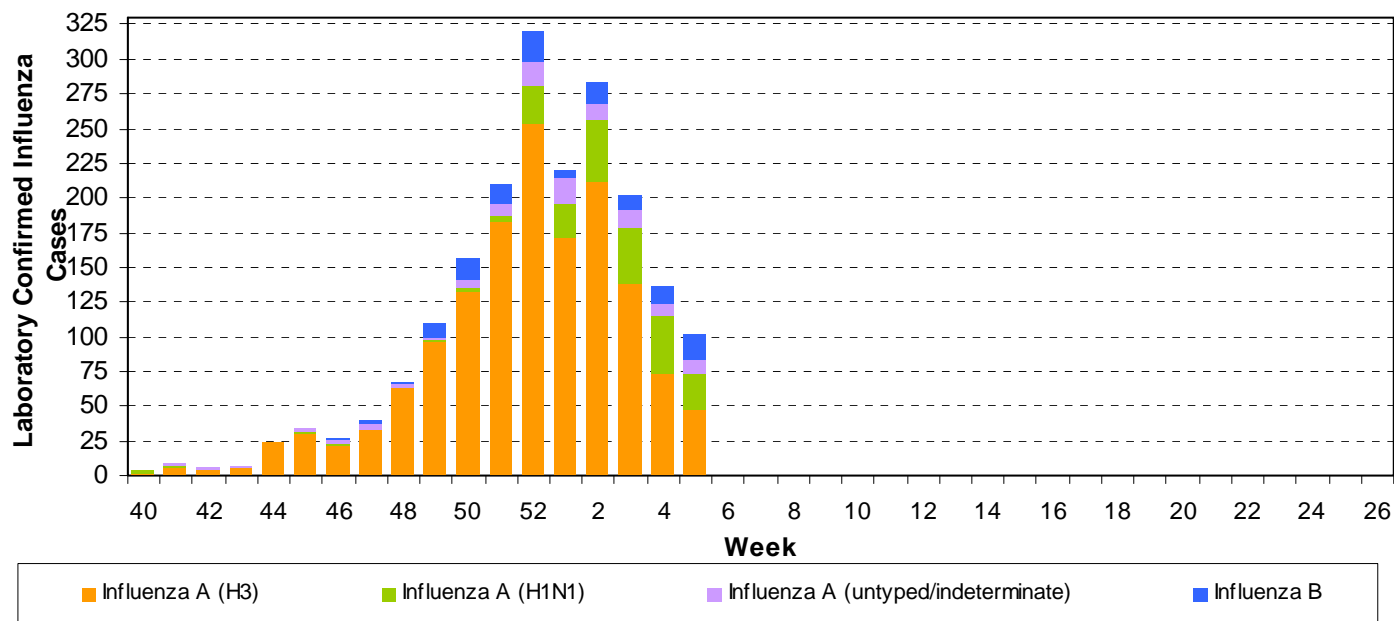

Section 3: Isolates

In the 2012/13 influenza season, the Provincial Laboratory for Public Health (PLPH) has reported 1832 Influenza A cases and 133 Influenza B cases to Alberta Health. In week 4 there were 137 lab confirmed influenza cases reported to Alberta Health, and in week 5 there were 103* lab confirmed influenza cases reported to Alberta Health.

Laboratory Confirmed Influenza Cases by Strain Type, 2012/13

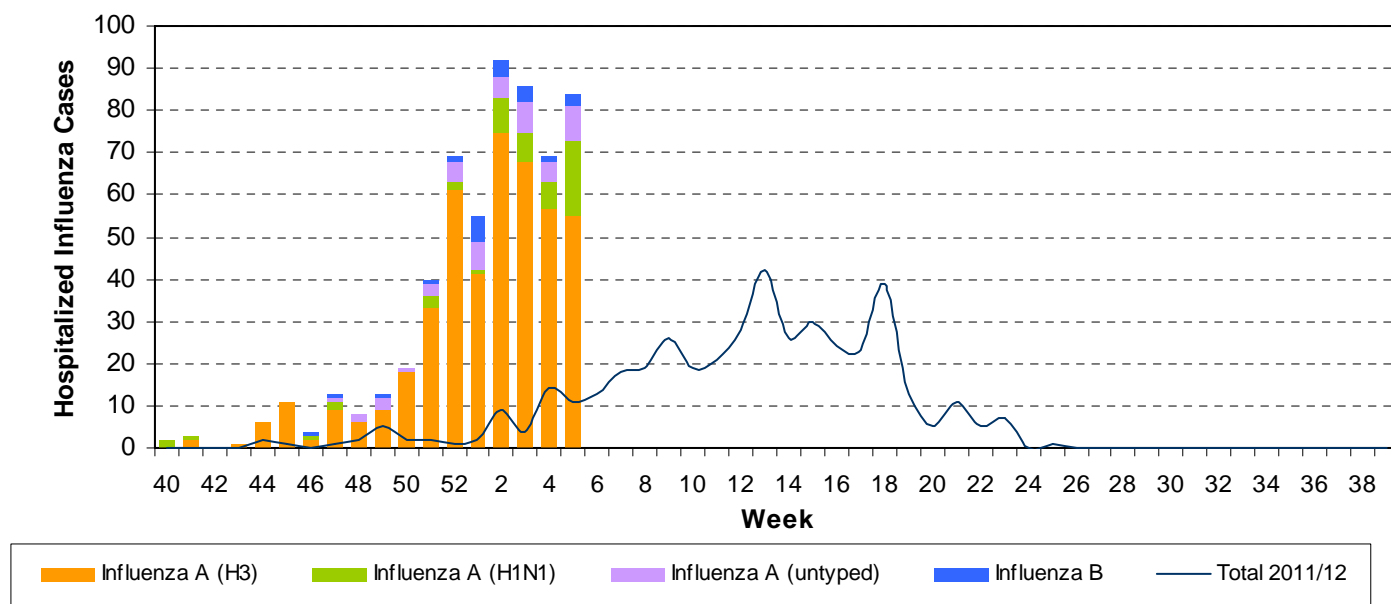

Section 4: Hospitalizations

There were 84* new hospitalized cases of influenza reported in week 5, and 69 confirmed hospitalized cases in week 4. There have been 575 hospitalized cases in total for this influenza season.

Section 5: Influenza-Like Illness – TARRANT-Week 5

Sentinel physicians report cases of ILI seen in their practices. 58 cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 4 and 32 cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 5.

Section 7: Antiviral Resistance

- There have been no influenza isolates identified that are resistant to amantadine, zanamivir or oseltamivir in the 2012/13 influenza season.
- In the 2011/12 season there were 10 isolates that were resistant to amantadine and no isolates were resistant to zanamivir or oseltamivir.
