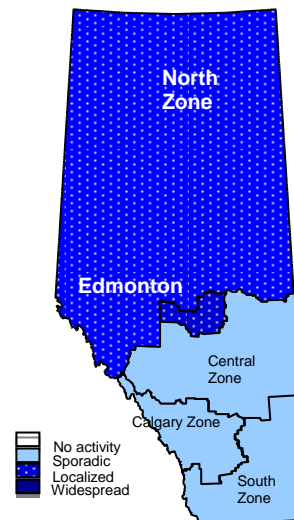


**Section 1: Summary**

<b>Edmonton</b>	▪ Localized activity. ▪ There are laboratory confirmed influenza cases and one outbreak.
<b>North</b>	▪ Localized activity. ▪ There are laboratory confirmed influenza cases and one outbreak.



**Section 2: Outbreaks**

There are three new outbreaks to report this week. Including the outbreaks reported in week 48 there have been 15 influenza outbreaks this season.

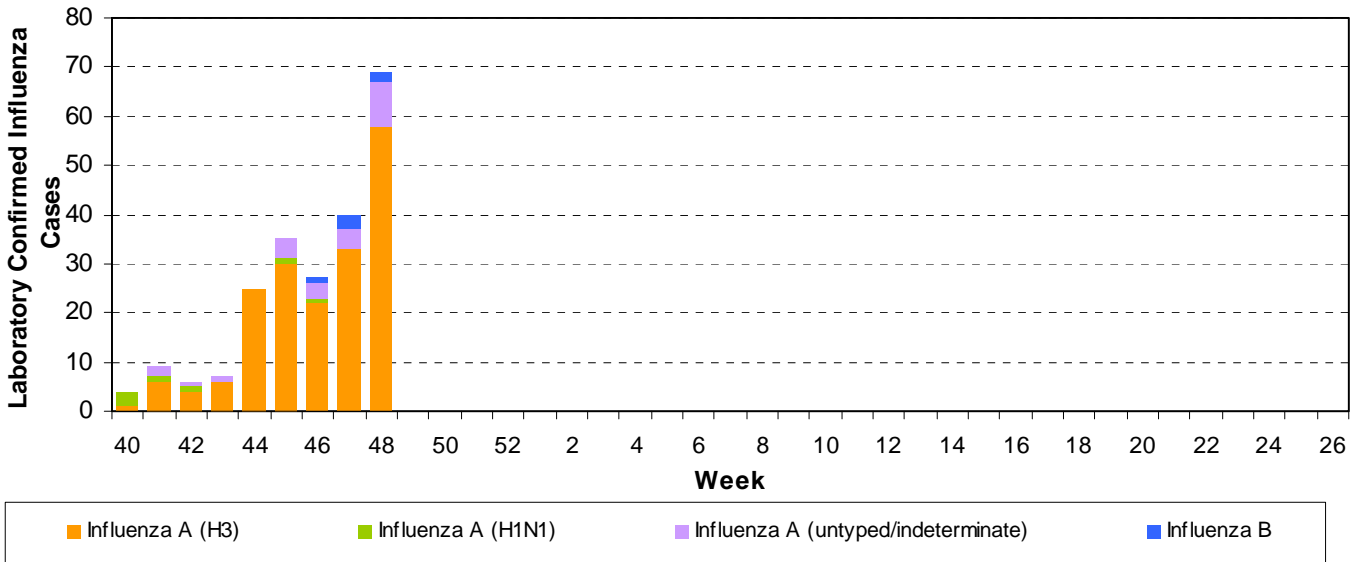

**Section 3: Isolates**

In the 2012/13 influenza season, the Provincial Laboratory for Public Health (PLPH) has reported 216 Influenza A isolates and 6 Influenza B isolates to Alberta Health.

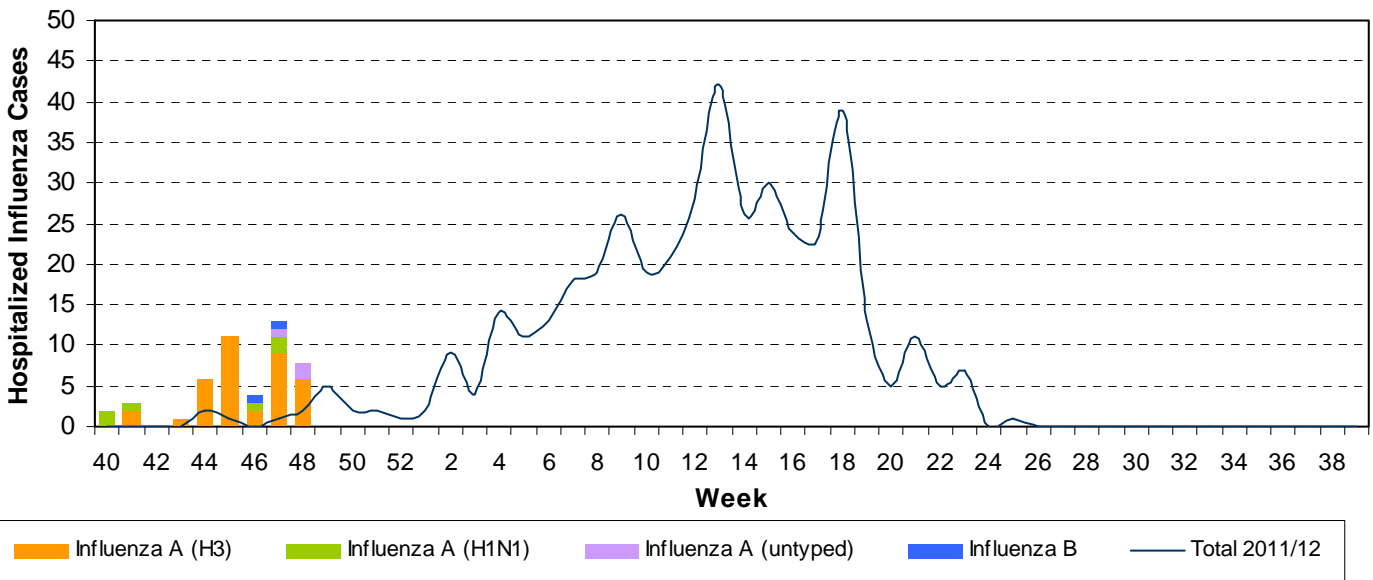
**Laboratory Confirmed Influenza Cases by Strain Type, 2012/13**

### Section 5: Influenza-Like Illness – TARRANT-Week 48

Sentinel physicians report cases of ILI seen in their practices. Thirteen cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 48.

### Section 7: Antiviral Resistance

- There have been no influenza isolates identified that are resistant to amantadine, zanamivir or oseltamivir in the 2012/13 influenza season.
- In the 2011/12 season there were 10 isolates that were resistant to amantadine and no isolates were resistant to zanamivir or oseltamivir.
