
There is one new influenza outbreak to report this week. There were a total of 0 outbreaks in week 8. There have been 79 influenza outbreaks this season.

Section 3: Isolates

In the 2012/13 influenza season, the Provincial Laboratory for Public Health (PLPH) has reported 1967 Influenza A cases and 228 Influenza B cases to Alberta Health. There were 67 lab confirmed influenza cases reported to Alberta Health in week 7 and 85* lab reported in week 8. Note that the number of Influenza B cases has increased between week 6 and week 8.




Laboratory Confirmed Influenza Cases by Strain Type, 2012/13

Section 4: Hospitalizations

There were 35* new hospitalized cases of influenza reported in week 8, and 26 confirmed hospitalized cases in week 7. There have been 680 hospitalized cases in total for this influenza season.

Section 5: Influenza-Like Illness - TARRANT-Week 8

Sentinel physicians report cases of ILI seen in their practices. 20 cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 8 and 18 cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 7.

- There have been no influenza isolates identified that are resistant to amantadine, zanamivir or oseltamivir in the 2012/13 influenza season.
- In the 2011/12 season there were 10 isolates that were resistant to amantadine and no isolates were resistant to zanamivir or oseltamivir.
