


Week 3 January 13-19, 2013

Section 2: Outbreaks


There are 10 new influenza outbreaks to report this week. There were a total of 16 outbreaks in week 2. Including the outbreaks reported this week there have been 73 influenza outbreaks this season.


Section 3: Isolates

In the 2012/13 influenza season, the Provincial Laboratory for Public Health (PLPH) has reported 1626 Influenza A cases and 99 Influenza B cases to Alberta Health. In week 2 there were 284 lab confirmed influenza cases reported to Alberta Health, and in week 3 there were 202* lab confirmed influenza cases reported to Alberta Health.



Section 4: Hospitalizations

There were 85* new hospitalized cases of influenza reported in week 3, and 92 confirmed hospitalized cases in week 2. There have been 421 hospitalized cases in total for this influenza season.

Section 5: Influenza-Like Illness - TARRANT-Week 3

Sentinel physicians report cases of ILI seen in their practices. 49 cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 2 and 30 cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 3.

Section 7: Antiviral Resistance

- There have been no influenza isolates identified that are resistant to amantadine, zanamivir or oseltamivir in the 2012/13 influenza season.
- In the 2011/12 season there were 10 isolates that were resistant to amantadine and no isolates were resistant to zanamivir or oseltamivir.
