Section 2: Outbreaks

There are two new outbreaks to report this week in long-term care facilities in the Edmonton. Including the outbreaks reported in week 44 there have been 6 influenza outbreaks this season. All of the outbreaks have been in long-term care or supportive living facilities.



Section 3: Isolates

In the 2012/13 influenza season, the Provincial Laboratory for Public Health (PLPH) has confirmed 50 Influenza A isolates and no Influenza B isolates. Week 44 saw the sharpest increase in laboratory confirmed cases, with 24 new cases reported.


Laboratory Confirmed Influenza Cases by Strain Type, 2012/13



Section 4: Hospitalizations

There are 5 new hospitalized cases of influenza reported in week 44. All of the cases are from the Edmonton Zone and all of the cases are Influenza A (H3).

Sentinel physicians report cases of ILI seen in their practices. Thirteen cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 44.
