

#### Section 2: Outbreaks


There are 3 new influenza outbreaks to report this week. There were a total of 9 outbreaks in week 3. Including the outbreaks reported this week there have been 74 influenza outbreaks this season.

# Section 3: Isolates

In the 2012/13 influenza season, the Provincial Laboratory for Public Health (PLPH) has reported 1750 Influenza A cases and 113 Influenza B cases to Alberta Health. In week 3 there were 202 lab confirmed influenza cases reported to Alberta Health, and in week 4 there were 138\* lab confirmed influenza cases reported to Alberta Health.




#### Laboratory Confirmed Influenza Cases by Strain Type, 2012/13

## Section 4: Hospitalizations

There were 69\* new hospitalized cases of influenza reported in week 4, and 86 confirmed hospitalized cases in week 3. There have been 491 hospitalized cases in total for this influenza season.

### Section 5: Influenza-Like Illness - TARRANT-Week 4

Sentinel physicians report cases of ILI seen in their practices. 44 cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 3 and 50 cases of influenza like illness (ILI) were seen in week 4.

### Section 7: Antiviral Resistance

- There have been no influenza isolates identified that are resistant to amantadine, zanamivir or oseltamivir in the 2012/13 influenza season.
- In the 2011/12 season there were 10 isolates that were resistant to amantadine and no isolates were resistant to zanamivir or oseltamivir.
