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# **Background**

The Family Support for Children with Disabilities Program (FSCD) assesses the satisfaction and outcomes of families receiving services and supports on an biennial basis in order to track performance and inform planning.

After holding an open competition, Community and Social Services contracted Advanis to conduct the 2016 Family Survey.

# Methodology

- The survey (see Appendix A) was adapted from the one used in previous years and includes a combination of qualitative and quantitative questions that allowed participants the opportunity for examples and suggestions.
- In order to ensure that all families have the opportunity to respond, a census rather than sample approach was used.
- Accuracy targets on the number of surveys required by each region were set (see below) in order to ensure valid results. Targets were met for all regions.

# Methodology (Continued)

An introductory letter to respondents was developed to inform parents of the intention of the study, the voluntary nature of their involvement, and the confidentiality of the information they provided to the Consultant. The letter explicitly stated that their participation in the survey would in no way affect their status with the program.

Family Surveys were administered between Oct. 26 and Dec. 12:

- Initially, a letter was sent out to all families.
  - The letter included a link to the online survey that families could use to complete the survey.
  - Alternatively, families could phone in and request a paper version of the survey to fill out.

# Methodology (Continued)

 Approximately 2 weeks after sending the letters to families, phone calls were made to allow families to complete the survey over the phone.

In total, 8,370 letters were mailed out and a total of 1,979 surveys were completed for a response rate of 23.6%. This included:

- 15 paper surveys
- 885 phone surveys
- 1079 web surveys

# Methodology (Continued)

Throughout the report, statistical testing has been applied where applicable. When results between 2014 and 2016 are compared, an arrow ( $\uparrow$  or  $\downarrow$ ) indicates if 2016 is statistically larger or smaller (at the 95% confidence interval) than the 2014 response.

When more than two columns are shown, letters are used to denote statistical significance. In the example below, the letter B is used to indicate that column A (47%) is statistically higher than column B (41%) but not C and column C (42%) is not statistically higher than column B (41%).

# Methodology – Survey Type

Those who completed on the web are more likely to agree that the FSCD program has had a positive impact on their child overall. However, there is no statistical difference with agreement that the FSCD program has had a positive impact on their family overall.

# **Executive Summary**

- Similar to 2014, 88% of families in Alberta are satisfied with the FSCD program, with over a third being very satisfied.
- Email remains the top preferred communication method, with even more families mentioning this channel compared to 2014. Fewer would like to receive communication via their worker, mail, or telephone.
- Awareness of the FSCD Resource List and PPAC has increased since 2014, however, awareness of RPAC has not changed.
- In line with 2014, 92% of families agree that the FSCD program has had a positive impact on their child and 90% feel the program has had a positive impact on their family.
- Providing more information about available services (32%) remains the top way the FSCD program could be improved. Compared to 2014, more families indicate that they would like expanded services (26%) and more knowledgeable workers (20%).



Overall, 88% of families are satisfied with the FSCD program. Compared to 2014, there has been a shift towards more families feeling very satisfied.


#### **Overall Satisfaction with the FSCD Program**

#### **How FSCD Program was Found**






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# How do families prefer to receive general information?

Email continues to be the preferred information channel, increasing at the expense of most other channels.


#### **Preferred Information Channel**

#### Resources the FSCD has made the Family Aware of





# Reasons families may not be accessing FSCD

The top 3 reasons for not accessing FSCD continue to be a lack of awareness, being too overwhelmed, and difficulty accessing FSCD.










More families strongly agree that they participate in decisions, have the information they need, and know what to do if they disagree with a decision.

The relationship families have with their worker continues to be very positive.








# How the FSCD program could be improved






#### Benefits of Involvements with the FSCD Program

#### Other Benefits of Involvement with the FSCD Program





Additionally, a greater number of families strongly agree that the FSCD program has had a positive impact on their child in 2016 compared to 2014.


Positive Impact on Child and Family
