Alberta Security Infrastructure Program (ASIP) factsheet

Overview

The Alberta Security Infrastructure Program (ASIP) grant funds security assessments, related training, equipment, immediate response and security infrastructure improvements to facilities serving communities or identifiable groups at risk of hate or bias-motivated crimes or incidents.

Types of grants

There are two separate grant applications:

- a cost recovery grant (for reimbursement of expenses incurred after June 1, 2021);
 and
- a regular grant for security assessment, infrastructure and equipment purchases, and related training.

Eligibility

To be eligible for grant funding, organizations must:

- be a registered non-profit or charitable organization in good standing with the Government of Alberta, and
- serve one or more members of an identified group at risk of hate or bias-motivated activity because of their real or perceived:

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nationality
 ethnicity
 language
 colour
 religion/creed
 age
 mental disability
 physical disability
 gender identity
 sexual orientation
 other similar factors

Categories of Funding

Category A: Security Risk Assessment:

Up to \$10,000, as an advance or reimbursement, to hire a qualified security assessor to conduct a security assessment of a facility owned or leased by the applicant.

Category B1: Implementing Security Risk Assessment Recommendations

Up to \$25,000, as an advance or reimbursement, for purchase and installation of security infrastructure, and/or risk planning as recommended by the security risk assessment.

Category B2: Education and Training

Up to \$10,000, as an advance or reimbursement, to offer staff and volunteers of an eligible organization training to build capacity and resilience to prevent and respond to hate and bias motivated activity.

Category C: Security Response

Reimbursement of up \$10,000 for security guard support, and/or repairs to a facility after a crime resulting in uninsured damage occurs.
