Program Description:

This program provides Immigrants with Career and Employment Information Services (CEIS) and Job Placement services to assist them in gaining employment in Alberta. All clients have access to a Resource Centre at each of EMCN's primary locations to obtain updated labour market information, self-help tools, informational and instructional videos, and access to computers, as well as printing, scanning and faxing services. Clients participating in the 12-week Job Placement also have access to job placement facilitated training, career and employment counselling, career coaching, a job search club and employer referrals. Workshops are also provided to help with work search, career planning and personal life management. This program has a continuous intake.

Program Description:

Il s'agit d'un service à guichet unique pour fournir des informations sur les carrières, l'emploi et la recherche d'emploi en français. Le centre de ressources fournit des sites d'emplois, des ordinateurs, des téléphones et d'autres outils de recherche d'emploi; évaluation et soutien à la gestion des services; counseling d'emploi; ateliers de préparation à la carrière et à l'emploi (recherche / maintien d'emploi, techniques d'entrevue, élaboration de

curriculum vitae et de lettre de motivation); anglais en milieu de travail; cours d'exposition; offres d'emploi et service de placement de 12 semaines.

This is a one-stop service to provide career, employment information and supported job search services in French. The resource centre provides job boards, computers, telephones and other job search tools; assessment and service management support; employment counselling; career and employment preparation workshops (job search/maintenance, interviewing techniques, résumé and cover letter development); English in the workplace; exposure courses; job leads and a 12-week job placement service.

Program Description:

This is a group-based employability skills program that helps new immigrant youth in Edmonton prepare for future work, make career decisions and/or seek, obtain, and maintain employment.

It includes 10 weeks pre-employment training followed by 14 weeks of work experience. There are three intakes per year targeted to high barriered immigrant youth aged 19-30. Youth receive a living allowance.
