**Program Description:**

This is a group-based employability skills program that helps new immigrant youth in Edmonton prepare for future work, make career decisions and/or seek, obtain, and maintain employment. It includes 10 weeks pre-employment training followed by 14 weeks of work experience. There are three intakes per year targeted to high barriered immigrant youth aged 19-30. Youth receive a living allowance.
