## ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ORDER NO. EPO-EPEA-35819

WHEREAS on February 26, 2021, the Director signed, and on March 1, 2021 CP was served with an Environmental Protection Order (EPO-EPEA-35819) [the "Order"] setting out requirements to respond to the release of the Substance into the environment;

WHEREAS on February 24, 2021, CP had submitted to submitted to Alberta Environment and Parks ["AEP"], a document titled "Canadian Pacific Railway - Crowsnest Sub - Mile 99.2 Wildlife Management Plan" [the "Draft Wildlife Management Plan"];

WHEREAS the Draft Wildlife Management Plan was not stamped and signed by an independent third-party qualified professional currently registered in good standing with the Alberta Society of Professional Biologists (ASPB);

WHEREAS the Draft Wildlife Management Plan was reviewed by an AEP Senior Wildlife Biologist, who identified the following concerns:

- Potential utilization of dogs and rubber slugs to deter wildlife without authorization;
- Lack of detail regarding aversion and monitoring techniques to be used at night.

WHEREAS Clause 4 of the Order required CP, by not later than March 3, 2021, to submit to the Director, for the Directors written approval a written Wildlife Plan stamped and signed by an independent third-party qualified professional currently registered in good standing with the Alberta Society of Professional Biologists;

WHEREAS on March 3, 2021, at 17:53, CP submitted to AEP, a document titled "Addenda – Wildlife Management Plan – Crowsnest Lake Mile 99.2 Potash Spill", which was signed and stamped by a Professional Biologist registered in good standing with ASPB;

WHEREAS the March 3, 2021 "Addenda – Wildlife Management Plan – Crowsnest Lake Mile 99.2 Potash Spill" solely forms the Wildlife Plan as contemplated in the Order;

WHEREAS The Director accepts and approves the Wildlife Plan submitted by CP on March 3, 2021;

WHEREAS section 243 of the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* [the "Act"] provides authority for the Director to amend an environmental protection order;

Classification: Public

THEREFORE I, Coreen Bates, pursuant to section 243 of the Act DO HEREBY AMEND the Order as follows:

1. Adding Clause 19 as follows:

19. CP shall fully implement each of the actions set out the Wildlife Plan by not later than March 5, 2021, and continue implementing each one until otherwise notified by the Director.
