Persons with Developmental Disabilities (PDD)

Program Overview

The Persons with Developmental Disabilities (PDD) Program provides services to help adults with developmental disabilities live as independently as possible in their communities.

PDD provides information and referral services and monitors and evaluates the provision of those services in addition to the support provided by family, friends and community members. These supports ensure that individuals live as independently as possible and are fully included in their community.

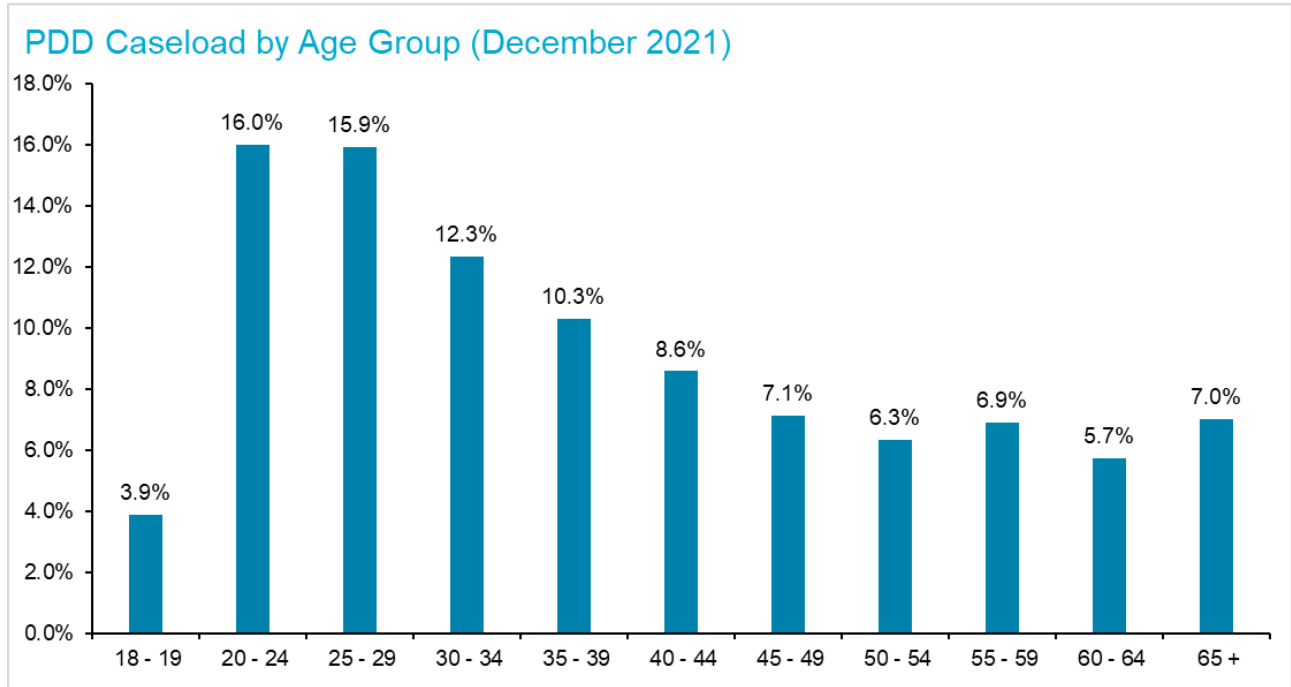
There are currently 11 PDD Open Data Asset Packages available for public use. These assets are updated on a quarterly basis and include the following datasets:

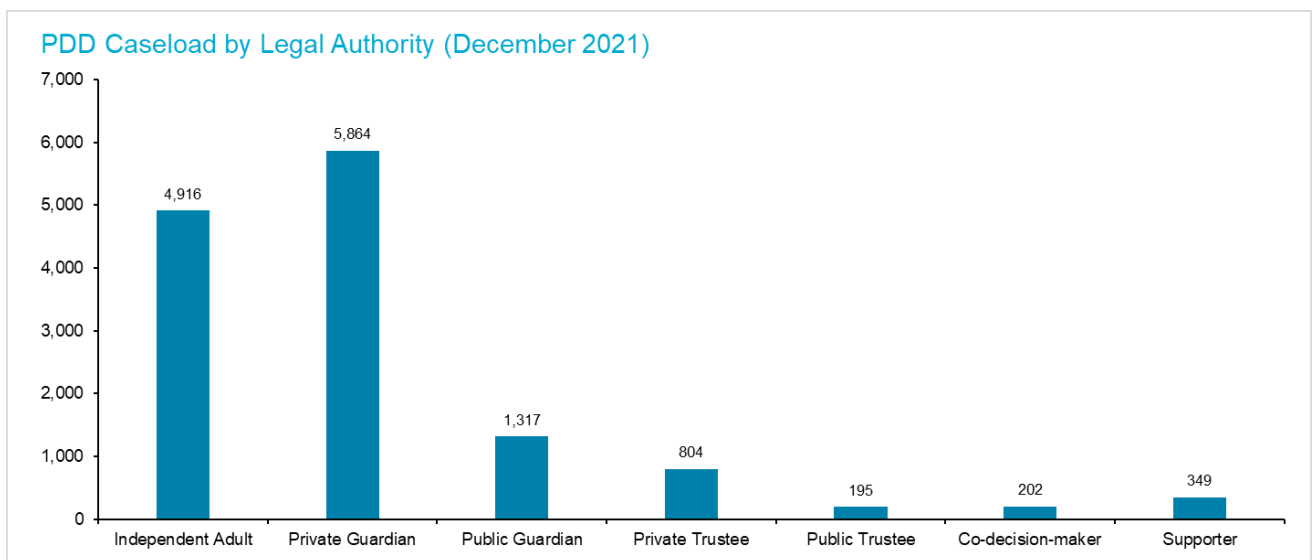
PDD - Caseload by Age Group

- Caseload by Age Group showed the highest proportion of PDD clients were aged between 20-24 years (16.0%) for December 2021, followed by 25-29 years (15.9%), 30-34 years (12.3%), 35-39 years (10.3%), 40-44 years (8.6%).



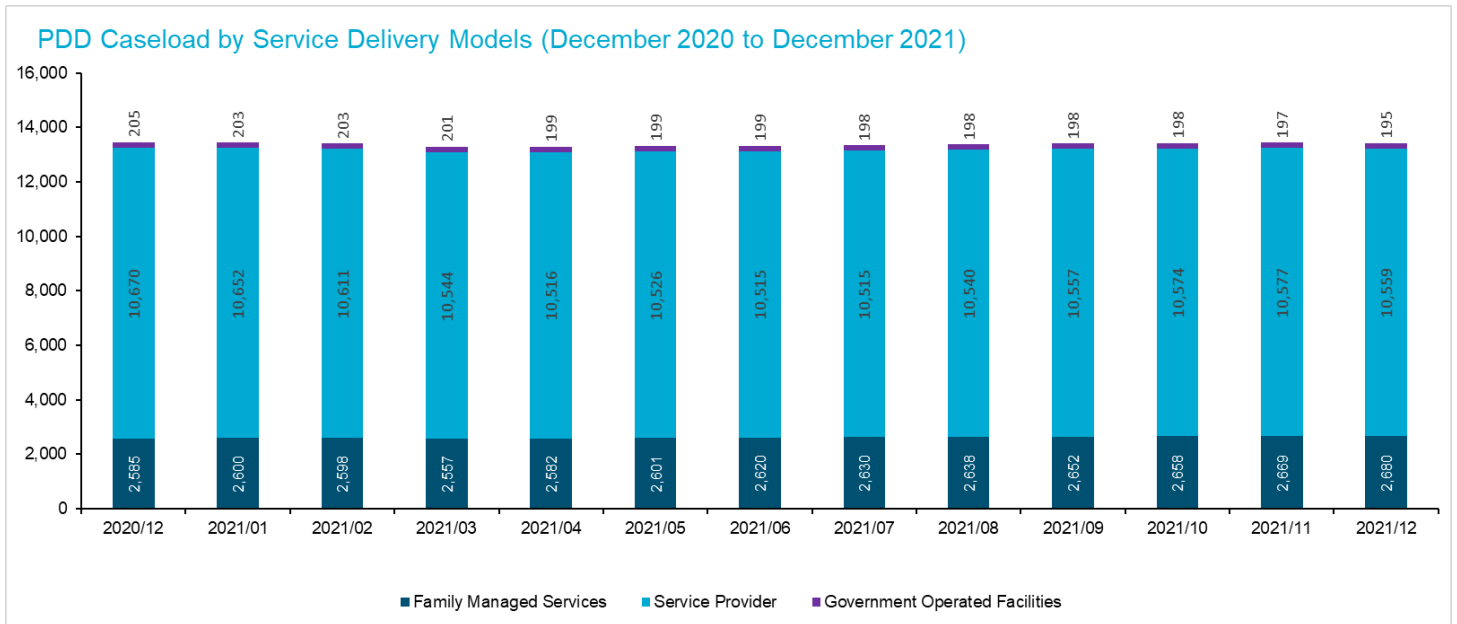
PDD - Caseload by Legal Authority

- The Private Guardian caseload had the highest proportion of caseload by Legal Authority (43.0%) for December 2021, followed by Independent Adult (36.0%), Public Guardian (9.7%), Private Trustee (5.9%), Supporter (2.6%), Co-decision-maker (1.5%).



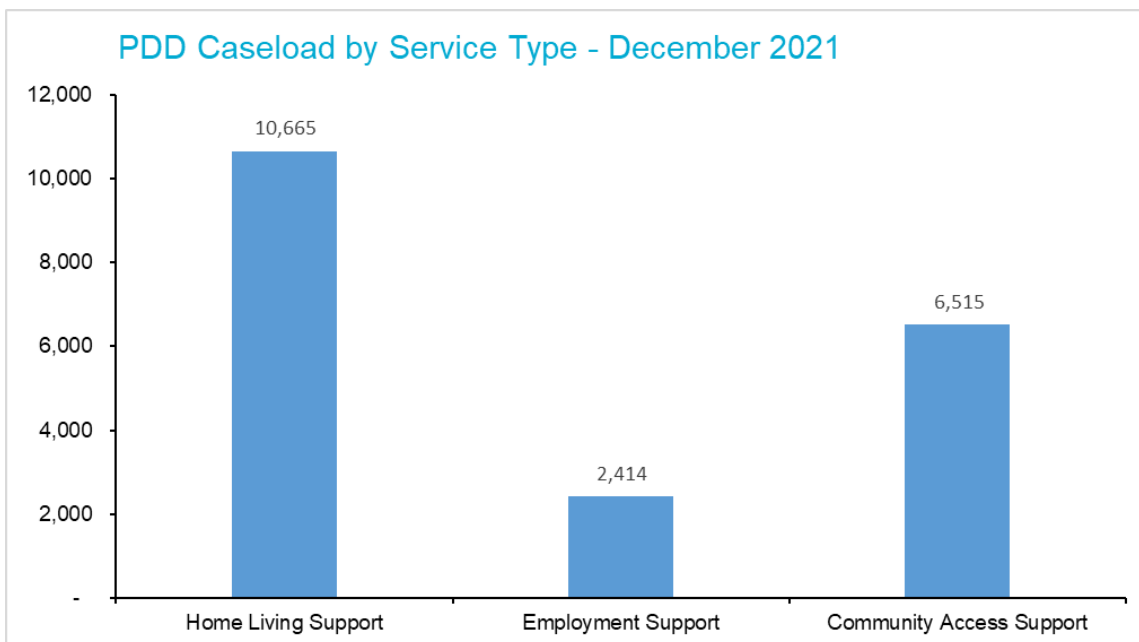
PDD - Caseload by Service Delivery Model

- Caseloads by Service Delivery Model totals for December 2021 include Family Managed Services (2,680), Service Providers (10,559), and Government Operated Facilities (195).



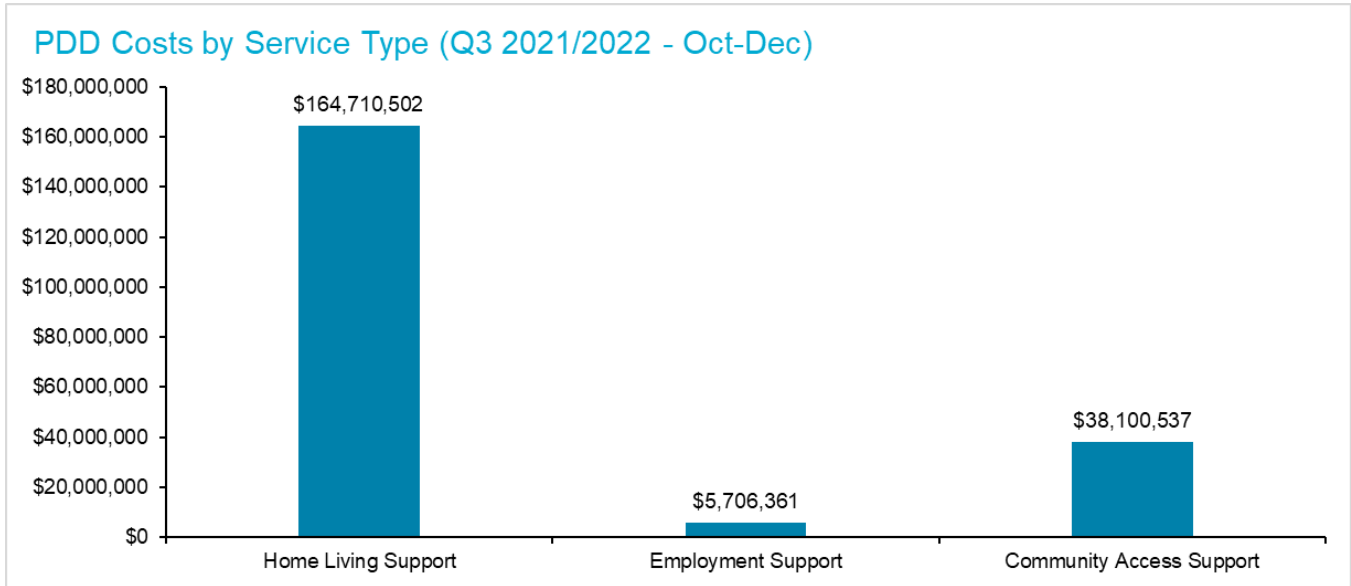
PDD - Caseload by Service Type

- The Home Living Support caseload had the highest proportion of caseload by Service Type (54.4%) for December 2021, followed by Community Access Support (33.2%), and Employment Support (12.3%).



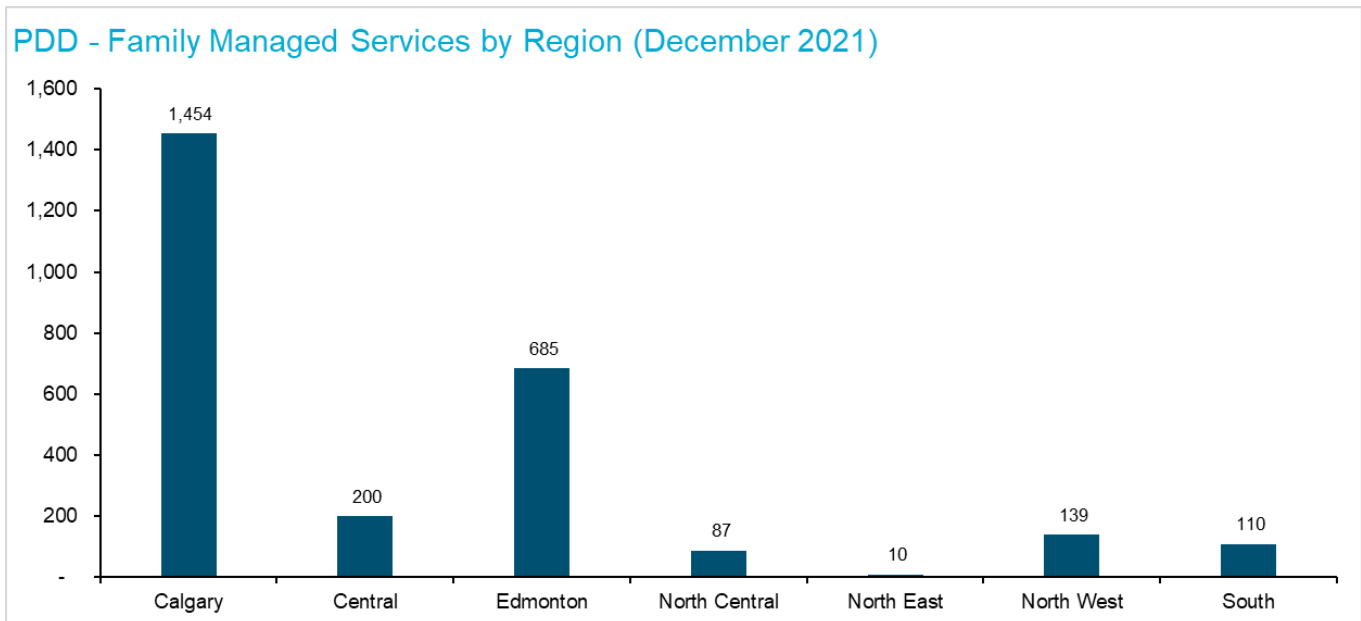
PDD - Cost by Service Type

- Home Living Support had the highest cost (79.9%) for the third quarter of 2021/2022, followed by Community Access Support (18.3%), and Employment Support (2.7%).



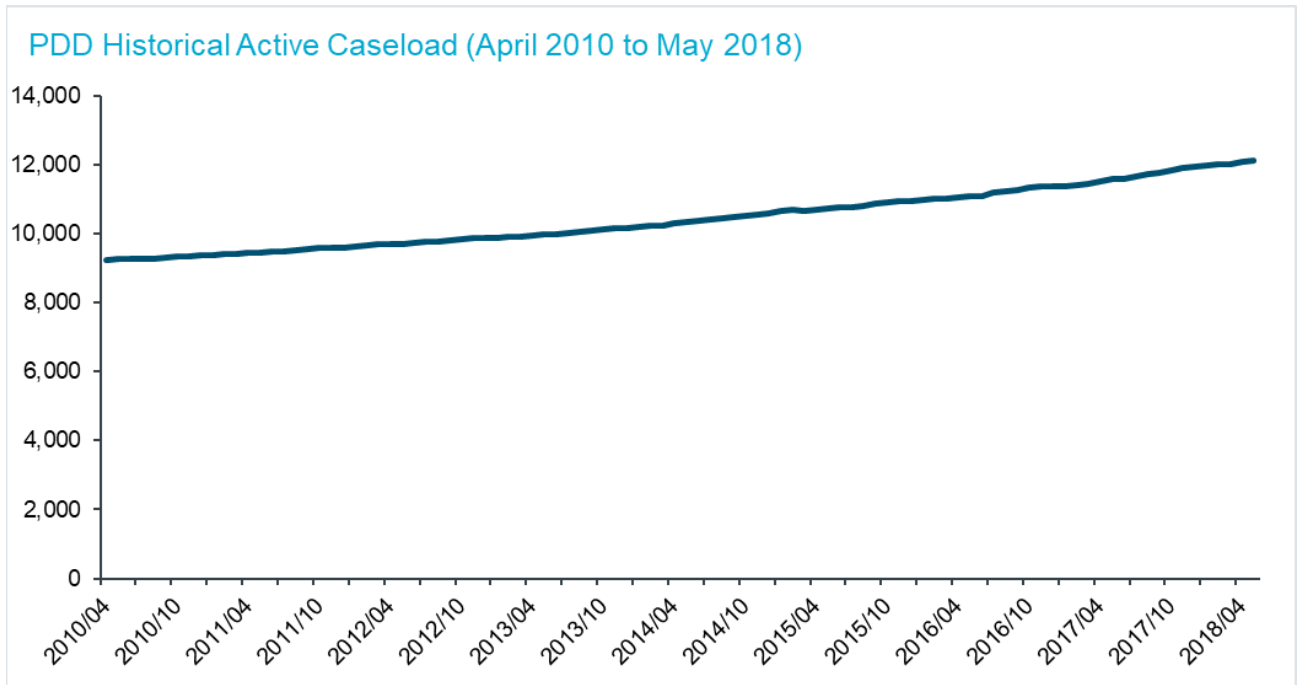
PDD - Family Managed Services by Region

- The Calgary region had the highest proportion of individuals (54.3%) using Family Managed Services for December 2021, followed by Edmonton (25.6%), Central (7.5%), North West (5.2%), South (4.1%), North Central (3.2%), and North East (0.4%).



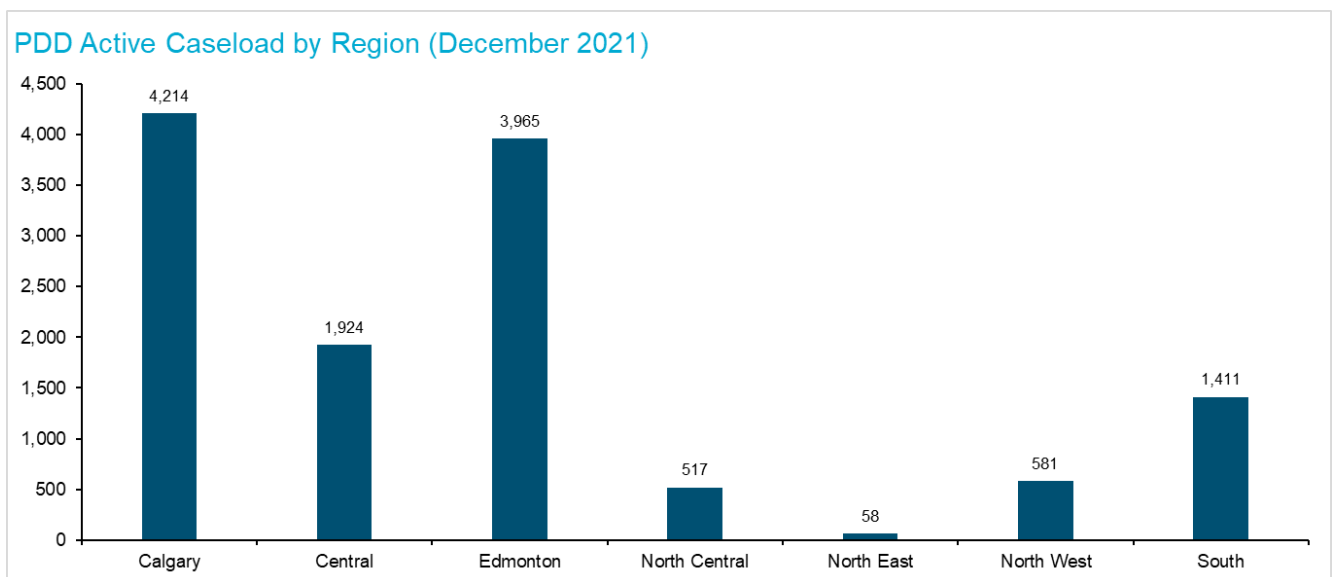
PDD Historical Active Caseload April 2010 – May 2018

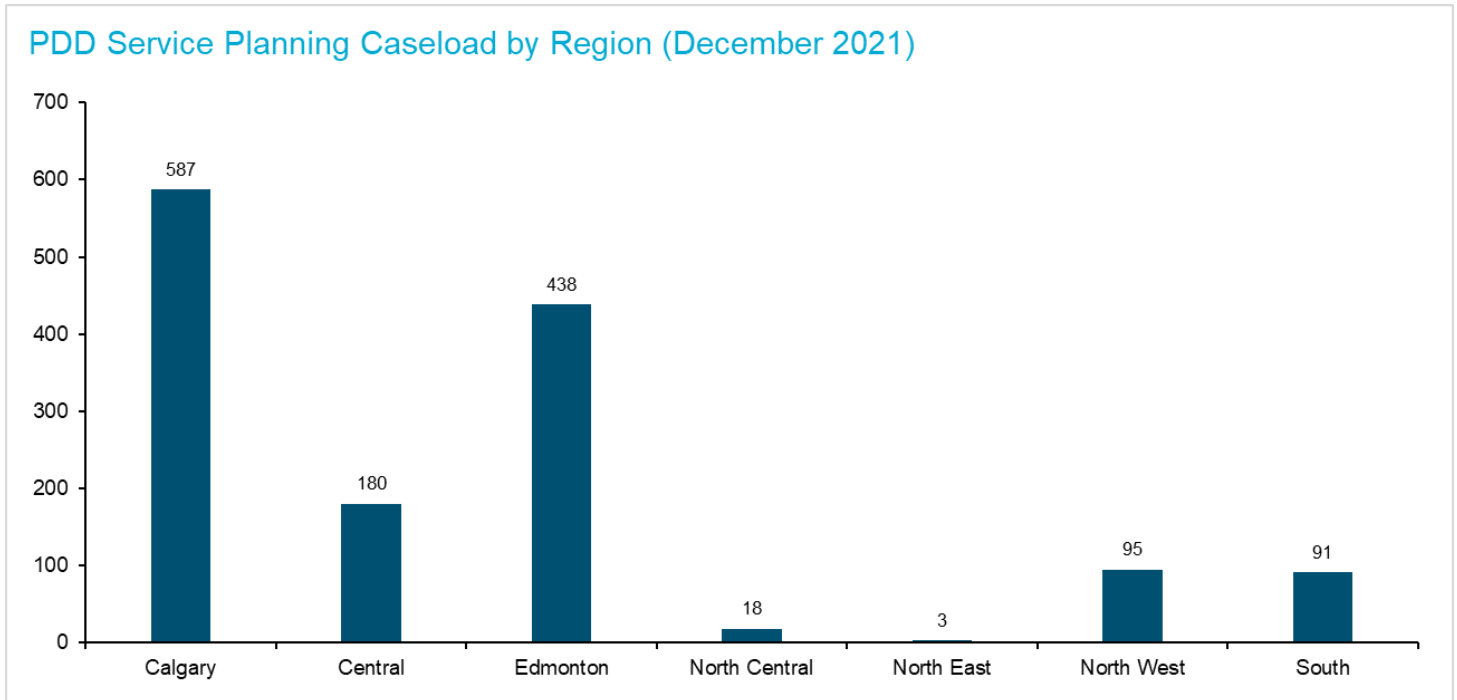
PDD - Active Caseload by Region

- The PDD Active Caseload total was 12,640 for December 2021, which is a decrease of 0.1% from the previous month of November 2021. From December 2020 to December 2021, the active caseload shows an increase of 0.5%.
- The Calgary region had the highest proportion of caseloads (33.3%) for December 2021, followed by Edmonton (31.4%), Central (15.2%), South (11.2%), North West (4.6%), North Central (4.1%), and North East (0.5%).



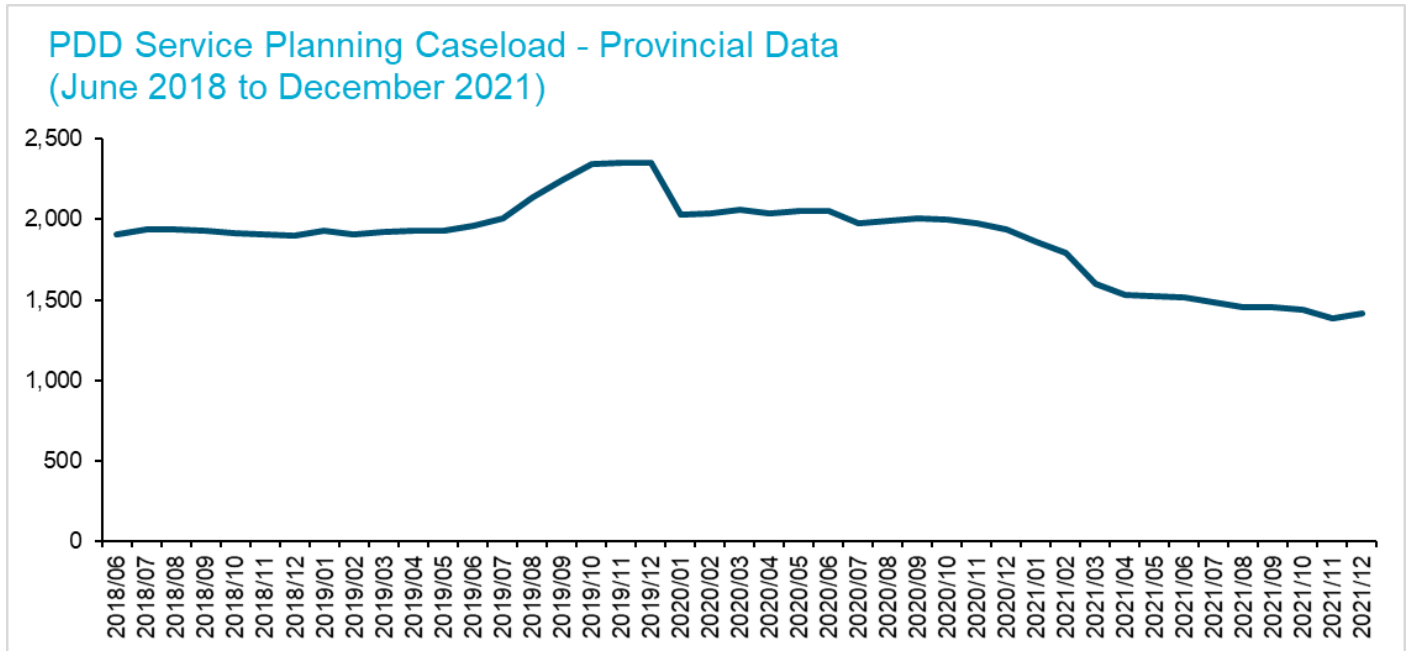
PDD - Service Planning Caseload by Region

- The Calgary region had the highest proportion of Service Planning caseloads (41.6%), for December 2021, followed by Edmonton (31.0%), Central (12.7%), North West (6.7%), South (6.4%), North Central (1.3%), and North East (0.2%).



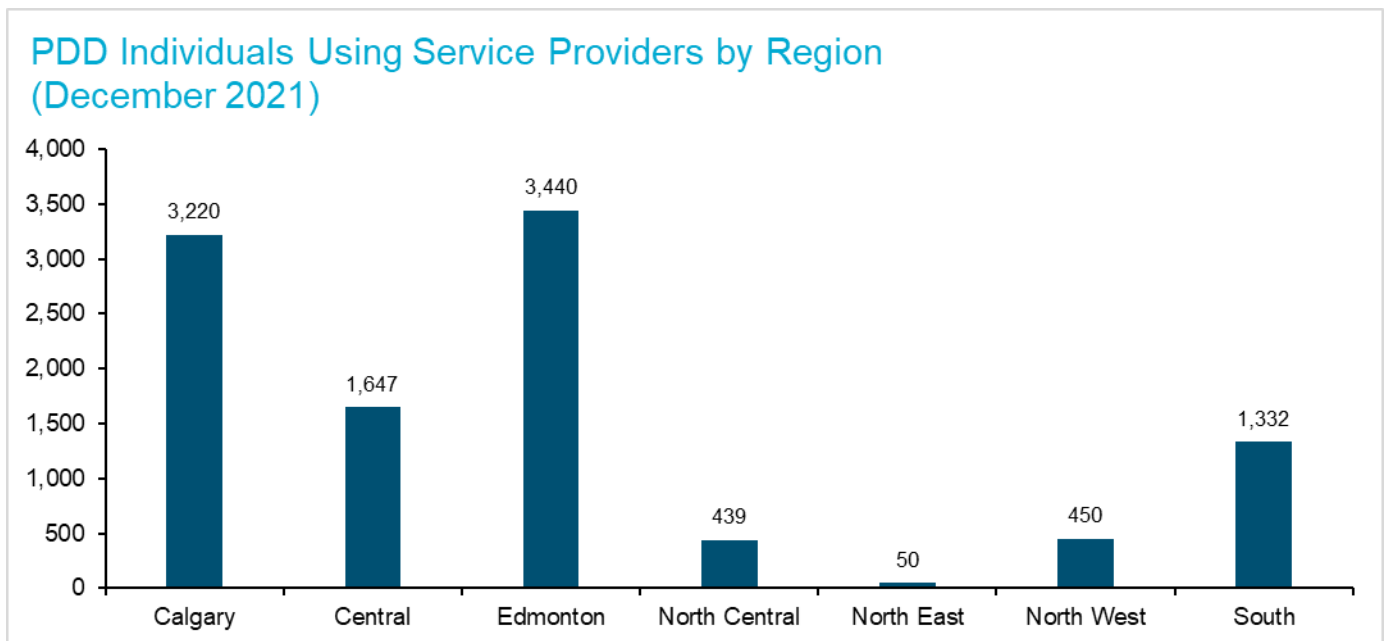
PDD - Service Planning Caseload – Provincial

- The Service Planning Caseload total was 1,412 for December 2021, which shows a decrease of 2.0% from the previous month of November 2021. From December 2020 to December 2021, the Service Planning Caseload shows a decrease of 27.0%.



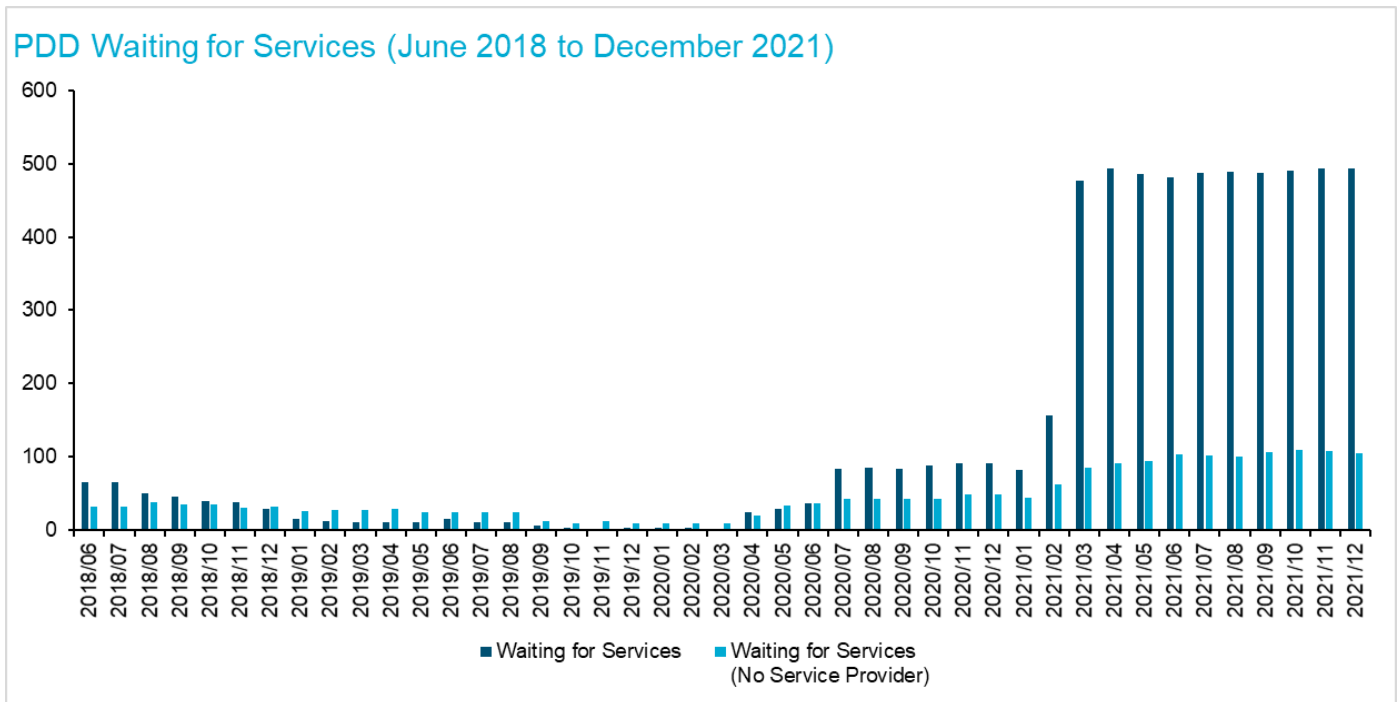
PDD - Service Providers by Region

- The Edmonton region had the highest proportion of individuals (30.5%) using Service Providers for December 2021, followed by Calgary (30.5%), Central (15.6%), South (12.6%), North West (4.3%), North Central (4.2%), and North East (0.5%).



PDD - Waiting for Services

- The Waiting for Services total was 493 for December 2021, and the Waiting for Services (No Service Provider) total was 105.
