

Labour Force Statistics Aboriginal People (Off-Reserve) December 2012

Alberta Aboriginal People Highlights:

- The unadjusted three-month moving average unemployment rate for Aboriginal people living off-reserve fell 2.3 percentage points in December 2012 to 10.2%, compared to the previous month.
- The labour force decreased by 1,700 and employment increased by 500 between November and December 2012.
- The unemployment rate for Aboriginal men fell to 7.9% in December 2012 from 9.9% in November 2012, and for women to 12.8%, from 15.3% over the same period.
- Between December 2011 and December 2012, employment of Aboriginal people decreased by 1,200 in Edmonton and increased by 2,700 in Calgary.
- Compared to the month before, employment was higher in four industries for Aboriginal people: Finance, Insurance, Real Estate and Leasing, 1,100; Accommodation and Food Services, 1,200; and Educational Services, 800.
