

Labour Force Statistics Aboriginal People (Off-Reserve) November 2012

Alberta Aboriginal People Highlights:

- The unadjusted three-month moving average unemployment rate for Aboriginal people living off-reserve fell 0.8 percentage points in November 2012 to 12.5%, compared to the previous month.
- The labour force decreased by 2,900 and employment fell by 1,900 between October and November 2012.
- The unemployment rate for Aboriginal men fell to 9.9% in November 2012 from 10.6% in October 2012, and for women to 15.3%, from 16.2% over the same period.
- Between November 2011 and November 2012, employment of Aboriginal people increased by 2,100 in Edmonton and declined by 800 in Calgary.
- Compared to the month before, employment was higher in four industries for Aboriginal people: Finance, Insurance, Real Estate and Leasing, 1,600; Other Services, 400; Information, Culture and Recreation, 400; and Public Administration, 100.
