

Labour Force Statistics Aboriginal People (Off-Reserve) October 2012

Alberta Aboriginal People Highlights:

- The unadjusted three-month moving average unemployment rate for Aboriginal people living off-reserve rose 1.3 percentage points in October 2012 to 13.3%, compared to the previous month.
- The labour force decreased by 800 and employment fell by 1,800 between September and October 2012.
- Between October 2011 and October 2012, employment increased by 6,200 in Edmonton and fell by 2,600 in Calgary.
- The unemployment rate for Aboriginal men rose to 10.6% in October 2012 from 9.7% in October 2011, and for women to 16.2%, from 11.8% over the same period.
- The three industries with the largest increases in employment from the previous month were: Finance, Insurance, Real Estate and Leasing, 1,100; Accommodation and Food Services, 600; and Other Services, 400.
