Brief History

Products

The settlement that was to become the Village of Rycroft was originally situated due west of the present townsite in the early 1900s. Bill English and Doc Calkin had the first store at that site. The community followed the railroad to its present site on the east side of the Spirit River. This was once a major railroading community complete with a roundhouse, a station and a dam site, which has been turned into a recreational area.

Rycroft was incorporated as a village in March, 1944, and like the proverbial Phoenix, it has risen from the ashes of two major debilitating fires in the business sector. Rycroft Hotel was the only business on Main Street left unscathed.

The village has continued to grow and prosper with an 11.3% population increase over the past 5 years. Five new businesses have opened in the last year.
