- 27,465 Florida jobs are supported by trade with Alberta.
 - 620,200 Florida jobs are supported by trade with Canada overall.
- Canada is Florida's second largest foreign export market.
- On average, 162,000 Albertans travel to Florida each year.

Florida – Alberta trade (\$USD)

- Bilateral trade: **\$1.58 billion**
- Florida exports to Alberta: **\$1.09 billion**
- Florida imports from Alberta: **\$495 million**



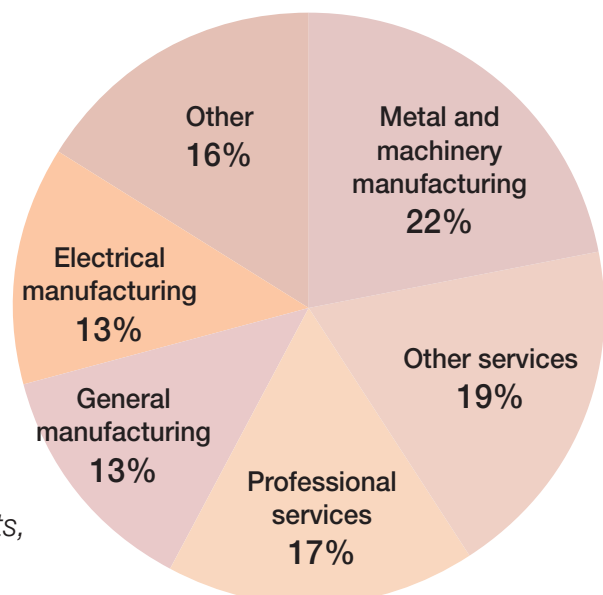
Florida's top exports to Alberta (\$USD)

- Metal and machinery manufacturing: **\$240 million**
- Other services: **\$205 million**
- Professional services: **\$180 million**
- General manufacturing: **\$145 million**
- Electrical manufacturing: **\$145 million**

Distribution of Florida Exports to Alberta

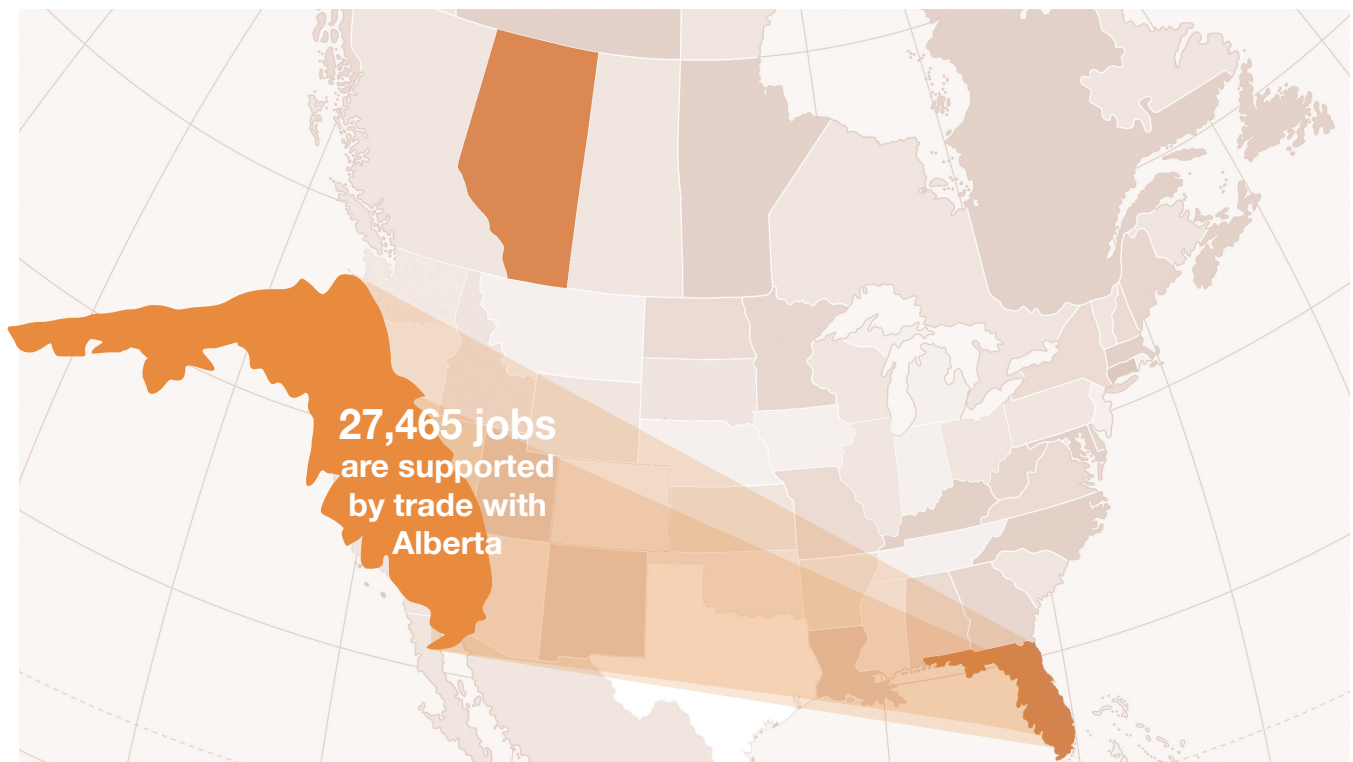
