Director Order

WHEREAS a Director may, pursuant to section 23 of the *Occupational Health and Safety Act*, issue a recognition of an alternative standard that complies with the requirements of an agreement entered into between Alberta and another Canadian jurisdiction if, in the Director's opinion, such an alternate standard is appropriate to the Alberta conditions;

AND WHEREAS the Province of Alberta signed the Pan Canadian Occupational Health and Safety Reconciliation Agreement on January 24, 2022 and has agreed to recognize common standards for occupational health and safety requirements across Canada;

AND WHEREAS Occupational Health and Safety is satisfied that recognition of the alternative standards, personal protective equipment and equipment specified in the Pan Canadian Occupational Health and Safety Reconciliation Agreement signed on January 6, 2022, is appropriate to the Alberta conditions;

- I, Lisa Chen, Executive Director, Occupational Health and Safety Program Delivery, and a Director under the Occupational Health and Safety Act, hereby:
 - 1. Recognize the alternative standards, personal protective equipment and equipment identified in the attached Schedule.

Please be advised that the Occupational Health and Safety Act requires that a person to whom a recognition applies shall ensure that the recognition or the original legislative requirement is complied with.

This order and recognition shall be in effect until January 24, 2027 unless it is varied, suspended or revoked by a Director at an earlier date.

This order and recognition may be varied, suspended or revoked by a Director at any time.

This order and recognition comes into effect on April 20, 2022.
