



Report to the Minister of Justice and Attorney General Public Fatality Inquiry

Fatality Inquiries Act

WHEREAS a Public Inquiry was held at the Provincial Court House in the Town of Cardston on the 20th day of October, 2006, before The Honourable Judge L.B. Hogan, a Provincial Court Judge.

A jury was not summoned and an inquiry was held into the death of MLAM, 6 of Standoff, Alberta and the following findings were made:

Date and Time of Death: November 13, 2004

Place: Standoff, Alberta

Medical Cause of Death: ("cause of death" means the medical cause of death according to the international Statistical Classification of Diseases, Injuries and Causes of Death as last revised by the International Conference assembled for that purpose and published by the World Health Organization - The Fatality Inquiries Act, Section 1(d)).

Multiple Blunt Injuries

Manner of Death: ("manner of death" means the mode or method of death whether natural, homicidal, suicidal, accidental or undeterminable - The Fatality Inquiries Act, Section 1(h)).

Accidental

Circumstances under which Death occurred:

Deceased was traveling on a gravel road with BETF. He had no seat belt on when Ms. ETF lost control and the vehicle left the road, striking a large boulder, resulting in the vehicle rolling over and both occupants being ejected from the vehicle.

That children and adults wear seatbelts at all times when traveling in a motor vehicle.
