Designated Ghost Operational Access Management Plan Trails

Motorized Uses - Permitted only on trails designated and posted.

- 4x4s - trucks, jeeps, quads, motorcycles, snowmobiles
- OHV - quads, motorcycles, snowmobiles
- Motorcycles - motorcycle use only
