**Take Notice** that Coal Valley Resources Inc. (CVRI) has applied to the Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB/Board) for approval to amend its existing mine permit, including mine and dump licences and to Alberta Environment (AENV) for licence renewal and approval to construct, operate, and reclaim the Mercoal West and Yellowhead Tower mine. The proposed Mercoal West and Yellowhead Tower mine project would be located in Townships 48 and 49, Ranges 21, 22 and 23, West of the 5th Meridian, about 90 kilometres (km) south of Edson, within Yellowhead County. The existing mine subject to Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act (EPEA) renewal is located in Townships 46, 47 and 48, Ranges 19, 20, 21, and 22, West of the 5th Meridian. The proposed extension will provide additional coal reserves of about 16.9 million clean metric tonnes, allowing the Coal Valley Mine to continue its operation until 2015.

This Notice of Application is being distributed to advise interested persons that the applications are available and that the ERCB, AENV, and other government departments are now undertaking review of the applications.

## **Nature of the Application**

In support of its proposal, CVRI has prepared and submitted the following applications:

- Application No. 1564181 to the ERCB, pursuant to Part 4, Section 13 of the Coal Conservation Act and Part 1, Sections 5 and 8 of the Coal Conservation Regulations, to amend the existing permit (Permit No. 2005-6) to extend the mine site operations, including mine and dump licences. In support of its proposal and as part of this application to the ERCB, CVRI has also submitted an environmental impact assessment (EIA) report to AENV. The EIA report forms part of the application to the ERCB.
- Application No. 019-11066 to AENV, pursuant to Part 2, Division 2, and Section 66 of the EPEA for an EPEA approval for the construction, operation, and reclamation of the Mercoal West and Yellowhead Tower mine. The proposed Mercoal West and Yellowhead Tower mine would require about 522 and 822 hectares (ha) of disturbance. Soil material would be conserved for reclamation. The disturbed areas would be reclaimed to primary production forest, wildlife habitat, and riparian features, including 15 water bodies, 14 being end-pit lakes/ponds and one wetland feature, with a total area of 63.4 ha.
- Application No. 019-11066 to AENV, pursuant to Part 2, Division 2 of EPEA, for a renewal of an existing approval for the continued operation and reclamation of the Coal Valley Coal Mine.
- Application No. 00247827 to AENV, pursuant to Sections 36 and 49 of the Water Act, for approval to construct works required for the construction, operation, and reclamation of the Mercoal West and Yellowhead Tower mine areas, including end-pit lakes, watercourse realignment, settling ponds, surface water management system, and pit dewatering sumps.
