ENFORCEMENT ORDER NO. WA-EO-2018/01-UAR

("Mourits")

WHEREAS Enforcement Order No, WA-EO-2018/01-UAR (the "EO") was issued to Mourits on April 10, 2018;

WHEREAS the EO required, among other things, that Mourits submit to the Director for approval, a written Wetland Restoration Plan for the Impacted Wetlands located on the Lands, SW08, SE08 and NE05 (the "Plan") on or before July 31, 2018;

WHEREAS Mourits emailed an Environmental Protection Officer with Alberta Environment and Parks ("AEP") on June 29, 2018 and advised that he was having difficulty with his environmental consultant and wished to hire a different consultant, and asked for the July 31, 2018 date for the Plan to be extended:

WHEREAS Mr. Owen Butz, AEP Compliance Manager, Upper Athabasca Region, has been appointed a Director for the purposes of issuing and amending enforcement orders under the *Act* (the "Director");

WHEREAS the Director is of the opinion that Mourits requires additional time for a new consultant to prepare the Plan, and that further clarity is needed to the EO to specify that a Wetland Impact and Assessment Report must also be prepared;

THEREFORE, I, Owen Butz, AEP Compliance Manager, Upper Athabasca Region, pursuant to section 137 of the *Water Act*, DO HEREBY AMEND THE EO AND ORDER:

- 1. In Clause 2 of the EO, the date of "July 31, 2018" is deleted and "October 31, 2018" is inserted in its place.
- 2. The following is added to the EO after Clause 2;
- 2a. Mourits, on or before October 31, 2018, submit to the Director for approval a written Wetland Impact and Assessment Report ("the Report") for all Impacted Wetlands located on the Lands, SW08, SE08 and

NE05. The Report must adhere to the Alberta Wetland Impact and Assessment Report Directive and the Alberta Wetland Identification and Delineation Directive.

3. In Clause 3 of the EO, "and the Report" is added immediately after "The Plan".
