Re: BRADLEY PERROTT – Public Fatality Inquiry, Response to Recommendations

Thank you for providing the Honourable Judge V.H. Myers' report. This letter is to provide a response to the one recommendation potentially impacting AHS.

Recommendation 1

In a situation where an offender is under a Court ordered Probation Order to comply and follow his physician's treatments and prescriptions administered through FACS and/or AHS, that a process be established to inform Probation of:


- 1. What prescriptions/treatments/assessments and/or counselling have been prescribed to the patient/client and;**
- 2. In what form (email/letter/phone etc.) FACS would use to inform Probation of non-compliance and;**
- 3. At what point in time after the non-compliance FACS would inform Probation.**

Response

AHS accepts this recommendation. (In Progress)

The Forensic Assessment & Community Services (FACS) clinic in Edmonton established a standardized process and workflow for informing Probation of offender non-compliance to court orders and implemented this standardized workflow in March 2020. The standardized process includes the 3 elements listed within Recommendation 1. The Forensic Assessment & Outreach Services (FAOS) companion clinic in Calgary has reviewed the Edmonton process and will complete alignment of practice by June 30, 2022
