Alberta Labels for Part 10 Buildings

Discipline Building

Effective Date December 16, 2019

Summary The construction of relocatable industrial accommodations must comply with the requirements within Part 10 of the National Building Code-2019 Alberta Edition (NBC(AE)) by either the Alberta labeling program or certification through CSA A277 "Procedure for Certification of Prefabricated Buildings, Modules, and Panels". As per Sentence 10.1.1.4.(3), if a constructor chooses to comply through the labeling program, that constructor must be certified by the Provincial Building Administrator, and the building must carry the appropriate Alberta label.

Effective December 16th of 2019, the Provincial Building Administrator will no longer certify constructors under Part 10 and hence the Alberta labeling program will no longer be in effect. The 'Alberta label' as stated in Sentence 10.1.1.4.(3) will no longer be required for buildings under the scope of Part 10 Relocatable Industrial Accommodation.

Constructors currently under the Alberta Labeling Part 10 program will have a transition period until March 16th, 2020 to obtain their certification under CSA-A277.

The Building Code Variance, Standata 19-BCV-001 'Relocatable Industrial Accommodation Labeling' recognizes the acceptability of CSA A277 certification and eliminates the need for the Alberta Labeling Program.

(3) A *building* referred to in Sentences (1) and (2) must be constructed or renovated by a *constructor* certified by the *Provincial Building Administrator* and must carry the appropriate Alberta label.
