### **Put a Spring into your Footprint**

Spring is a time of growth and change. It is also a good time for us to spring into action and put the spring into our carbon footprints.

Here are some ideas to get the green back in your spring:

- Clean out the clutter. Donate gently used items to charities and donate winter clothes and boots to a homeless shelter early or have a garage sale.
- If you need something try finding it at local garage sales...reuse gently used items first before buying them new.
- Install a clothesline so you can hang your clothes (which were washed in cold water) outside. It's easier on your clothes and the environment.
- Plan you landscaping. Plant native plants and learn about invasive plants.
- Create habitat for insects and small animals. Learn more <u>here</u>. And <u>here</u> for schoolyard naturalization.
- Install a <u>rain barrel</u> to capture rain water for your backyard plants.
- Start frequenting your local <u>Farmers' Market</u>. Get in the habit of buying local produce and in-season.
- If you have never composted before, give it a try. Start with the organic matter from your kitchen and what you rake up from your lawn. More information <a href="here">here</a>.
