



### Alberta Farm Cash Receipts (\$ Billions)




In 2015, Alberta farm cash receipts totalled a record \$13.6 billion, 5.1% from 2014. This marks the second consecutive year of growth. Fuelling most of the increase were record livestock market receipts (up 6.0%), coupled with higher crop market receipts (up 2.8%) and program payments to producers (up 18.9%).

# Employment in Alberta Agri-Food Industries (Thousands of Persons)




In 2015, Alberta agri-food industries employed 89,200 persons or 3.9% of total employment in the province (2,301,100). Agriculture industries employed 62,800 persons with cattle ranching and farming workers representing the largest segment (17,600). At 26,400, food and beverage workers accounted for the largest proportion (18.9%) of total manufacturing employment (139,900) in the province.

## Alberta Food Manufacturing Sales (\$ Billions)



Alberta food manufacturing sales totalled \$13.6 billion in 2015. Sales increased 23.4% over 2014 with higher activity reported in most food segments. Sales for meat products jumped 28.6% to reach a record \$7.7 billion, accounting for 56.2% of food sales. Animal foods including feed were up 14.4% while grain and oilseed milling sales declined 5.9%.


#### Real Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for Alberta Agri-Food Industries, Per Cent Change From Previous Year



In 2015, Alberta's real GDP for agri-food industries was \$5.4 billion, practically unchanged from 2014. GDP for agriculture industries declined 4.3% to \$3.0 billion. Moderating the declines were food processing industries which reported an increase of 5.4% to \$2.4 billion.
