

## Law Enforcement Review Board Hearings – May 2016

The Law Enforcement Review Board will hear final arguments on the following appeals at Oxford Tower, 15<sup>th</sup> floor, 10025-102 A Avenue, Edmonton.

### May 12, 2016 (9 a.m.)

- Ms. Scott filed complaints alleging officers engaged in a negligent investigation, conducted an unlawful search, used excessive force and that her privacy was breached in that she was not informed that cells had video cameras in them. Ms. Scott also alleged that she was not immediately informed her of her right to counsel or provided with medical attention despite her requests.

### May 26, 2016 (9 a.m.)

- Mr. Gonzalez filed complaints alleging officers used excessive force when he was restrained following an incident involving his friends and the officers.

An independent body established pursuant to the *Police Act* in 1973, the Alberta Law Enforcement Review Board reviews public complaints about police officer conduct. The board also reviews police officers' appeals on disciplinary action.
