The Law Enforcement Review Board will hear final arguments on the following appeals in Edmonton and Calgary:

June 23, 2016 (9 a.m.)

- Ms. Scott filed complaints alleging officers engaged in a negligent investigation, conducted an unlawful search, used excessive force and that her privacy was breached in that she was not informed that cells had video cameras in them. Ms. Scott also alleged that she was not immediately informed her of her right to counsel or provided with medical attention despite her requests.

Federal Court of Canada, 3rd Flr, 635 – 8th Avenue SW, Calgary:

June 28 - 29, 2016 (9 a.m.)

- Sgt. Braille appealed the Presiding Officer's decision that he be dismissed from the Calgary Police Service.
