

Law Enforcement Review Board Hearings – November 2016

November 4, 2016

The Law Enforcement Review Board will hear final arguments on the following appeals in Edmonton:

November 14, 2016 (9 a.m.)

- Mr. J. Jackman initially filed a complaint alleging officers used excessive force during his arrest. Upon hearing the Law Enforcement Review Board returned the matter to the Chief of the Edmonton Police Service for re-investigation. Mr. Jackman appealed the Chief's decision arising from the re-investigation.

November 17, 2016 (9 a.m.)

- Mr. C. Beniuk filed complaints alleging excessive force, that he was unlawfully detained and that an unlawful search and seizure was conducted. Mr. Beniuk also alleged that officers failed to document all or some of the use of force and filed deceitful reports.

An independent body established pursuant to the *Police Act* in 1973, the Alberta Law Enforcement Review Board reviews public complaints about police officer conduct. The board also reviews police officers' appeals on disciplinary action.
