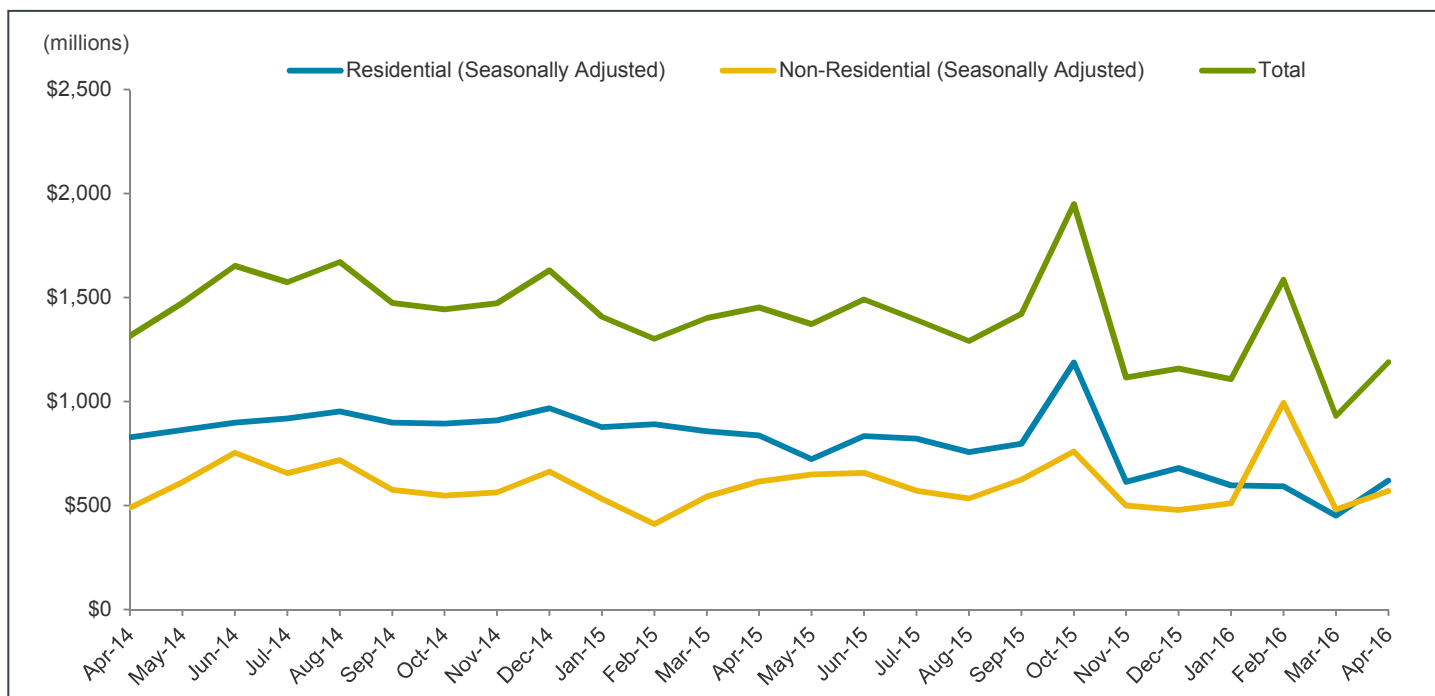
Value of Building Permits, Alberta

- In April 2016, the total value of Alberta's building permits¹ increased 27.7% to \$1.2 billion compared to March 2016. Residential permits accounted for 52.2% of the value of all building permits issued in Alberta in April.
- The total value of non-residential building permits increased 18.5% in April 2016 compared to March 2016 and the total value of residential building permits increased 37.5% over the same period.
- The total value of building permits in April 2016 was 18.1% lower than what was reported in April 2015. Over the course of that period, residential building permits decreased 25.9% while non-residential permits decreased 7.6%.
- The total value of building permits decreased 11.8% in the first quarter of 2016 compared to the same period in 2015. The value of residential building permits decreased 37.5% and non-residential permits increased 33.6%.
- In 2015, the total value of building permits decreased 8.2% compared to 2014, to \$16.8 billion.
