

Alberta Official Statistics

Traffic Collision Casualties, Alberta

In the past ten years:

- The lowest number of casualties was recorded in 2012 (18,565). Out of these, 345 (1.9%) were killed and 18,220 (98.1%) were injured.
- The highest number of casualties was recorded in 2006 (26,417). Out of these, 453 (1.7%) were killed and 25,964 (98.3%) were injured.
- The lowest number of fatalities was recorded in 2011 (313).
- The lowest number of injuries was recorded in 2012 (18,220).
