MINISTERIAL ORDER

027/2020

WHEREAS the Lieutenant Governor in Council made Order in Council 080/2020 under section 52.1(1) of the *Public Health Act* (PHA) on March 17, 2020 declaring a state of public health emergency in Alberta due to pandemic COVID-19 and the significant likelihood of pandemic influenza;

WHEREAS Order in Council 080/2020 has effect for 90 days following March 17, 2020 under section 52.8(1)(a) of the PHA;

WHEREAS section 52.1(2) and (3) of the PHA authorize the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry (Minister), to make an order without consultation, to suspend or modify the application or operation of all or part of an enactment the Minister is responsible for, subject to the terms and conditions the Minister prescribes, and to specify or set out provisions that apply in addition to, or instead of any provision of an enactment, if the Minister is satisfied that doing so is in the public interest;

THEREFORE I, Devin Dreeshen, Minister of Alberta Agriculture and Forestry responsible for the *Forests Act* and the *Forest and Prairie Protection Act*, pursuant to section 52.1(2) and (3) of the *Public Health Act*, do hereby repeal Ministerial Order 013/2020 and Ministerial Order 014/2020 as of the date of this Order.
