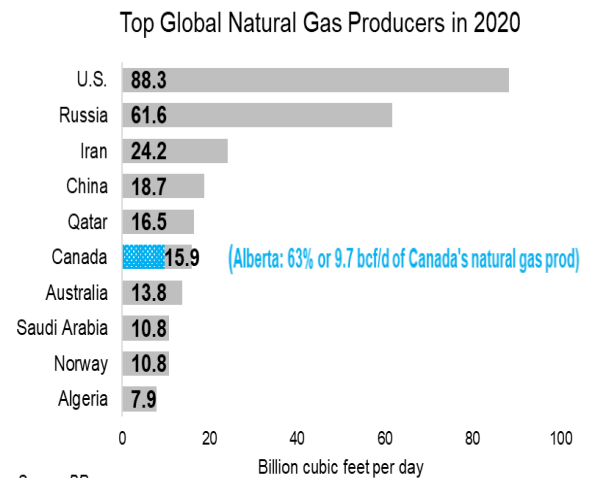
When currently available natural gas resources of 1,373 trillion cubic feet are considered, Canada should be able to produce natural gas for more than 200 years.

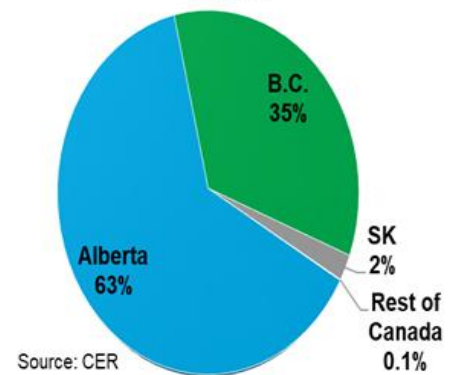

Estimated Canadian Natural Gas Production in 2020

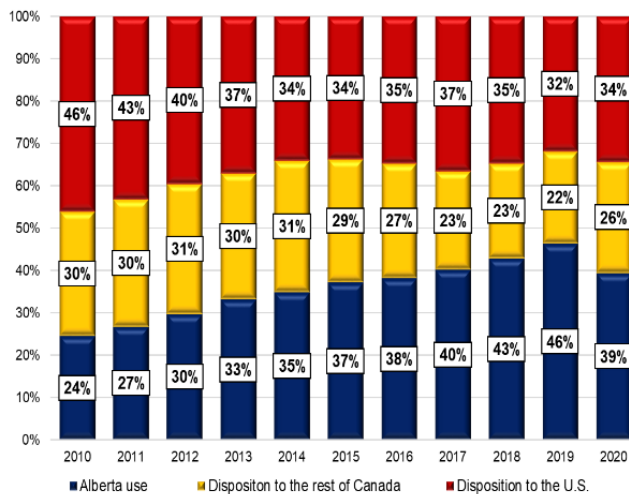
