LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS OF LOCATIONS

The legal descriptions are given in Alberta Township System (ATS) co-ordinates. A township within a specified range is a six-mile square, with 36 sections. Each section is a one mile (approximately 1609 metres) square. A legal description is given in the order of section-township-range-meridian, x offset and y offset. The x offset (first four numbers after the meridian) indicates how many metres west the location is from the NE corner of the section. The y offset (last four numbers) indicates how many metres south the location is from the NE corner of the section. The locations have been calculated from maps or aerial photos.

Examples:

S OF LOCAL RD 24-60-6-500000000	South of the local road located at the most northeast corner of section 24, township 60, range 6, west of the 5^{th} meridian.
W OF LOCAL RD 8-60-6-508050000	West of the local road located 805 metres west and 0 metres south of the northeast corner of section 8, township 60, range 6 west of the 5 th meridian.
S OF LOCAL RD 32-60-6-500008050	South of the local road located 0 metres west and 805 metres south of the northeast corner of section 32, township 60, range 6, west of the 5 th meridian.
