

Employment Insurance Beneficiaries Receiving Regular Benefits, Alberta

- The number of Albertans receiving regular Employment Insurance¹ (EI) benefits in April 2016 was 67,860.
- The number of El recipients increased by 820 in April 2016 compared to the previous month.
- Between April 2015 and April 2016, the number of Albertans receiving regular El benefits increased by 23,260 or 52.2%.
- 1 Employment Insurance (EI) provides regular benefits to individuals who lose their jobs through no fault of their own (for example, due to shortage of work, seasonal, or mass lay-offs), are available for work, able to work, but cannot find a job. The data are seasonally adjusted and estimates for the most recent two month periods are preliminary and subject to revisions.
