Re: Deciduous Pulp Dues Rates for the Period May 1 to May 31, 2023

This letter provides notice of Crown Timber and Forest Resource Improvement Association of Alberta (FRIAA) dues for deciduous pulpwood as established in the Timber Management Regulation and the Forest Resources Improvement Regulation.

Please submit your timber returns for the period May 1 to May 31, 2023, using the following rates:

	General Rate of Dues for Deciduous Timber used to make Pulp (\$/m³)
Crown Timber Dues	3.69
FRIAA Dues	1.99
Total Dues	5.68

These rates have been calculated in accordance with the Timber Management Regulation and the Forest Resources Improvement Regulation.
