This letter provides notice of Crown Timber and Forest Resource Improvement Association of Alberta (FRIAA) dues for deciduous pulpwood as established in the Timber Management Regulation and the Forest Resources Improvement Regulation.

Please submit your timber returns for the period January 1 to January 31, 2023, using the following rates:
