Place HIGHWAY #28 approximately 1.5 miles south of Grand Centre, Alberta

Medical Cause of Death ("cause of death" means the medical cause of death according to the International Statistical Classification of Diseases, Injuries and Causes of Death as last revised by the International Conference assembled for that purpose and published by the World Health Organization — The Fatality Inquiries Act, Section 1(d))

Lacerated liver with Hemoperitoneum.

Manner of Death ("manner of death" means the mode or method of death whether natural, homicidal, suicidal, accidental or undeterminable — The Fatality Inquiries Act, Section 1(g))

The deceased, [REDACTED] sustained injuries in a 3 vehicle
accident. His death was accidental.

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CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH DEATH OCCURRED

The deceased, a ward of the Province of Alberta, was a passenger in the rear seat of a small compact vehicle driven by Sam Spicer. At the time of the accident, the child was seated in a child restraint system.

The vehicle in which the child was a passenger, was stuck from the rear by a large, fast moving car driven by an apparently intoxicated male individual. This impact resulted in the Spicer vehicle being propelled forward into a vehicle pulling a hay rake.

The child sustained his life threatening injuries during the course of this chain of collisions.
