ASIRT investigations concluded on two files

The Alberta Serious Incident Response Team (ASIRT) has completed its investigations into two separate incidents and released full reports on them.

On Oct. 19, 2019, pursuant to Sec. 46.1 of the *Police Act*, ASIRT was directed to investigate a Calgary Police Service officer-involved shooting causing injury that occurred earlier that day. ASIRT's investigation is now complete.

On April 9, 2020, pursuant to Sec. 46.1 of the *Police Act*, ASIRT was directed to investigate the circumstances surrounding the death of a man who had been released from RCMP custody days earlier. ASIRT's investigation is now complete.
